## Planning your own route

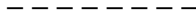
Once you have tried this trail, you may like to plan your own route. Hampshire has more than 3,000 miles of rights of way throughout the countryside.

**Cyclists may use the following rights of way ONLY:**



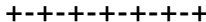
### Bridleways

**Distance:** 3 1/2 miles, all of which are off road.

**Start:** Hawthorns car park at Farley Mount Country Park, 3 miles west of Winchester on the Sarum Road, off Chilbolton Avenue. (Grid ref. 414292).

**Grade:** Easy

**Description:** A very easy-going circular route following forest tracks and a bridleway.

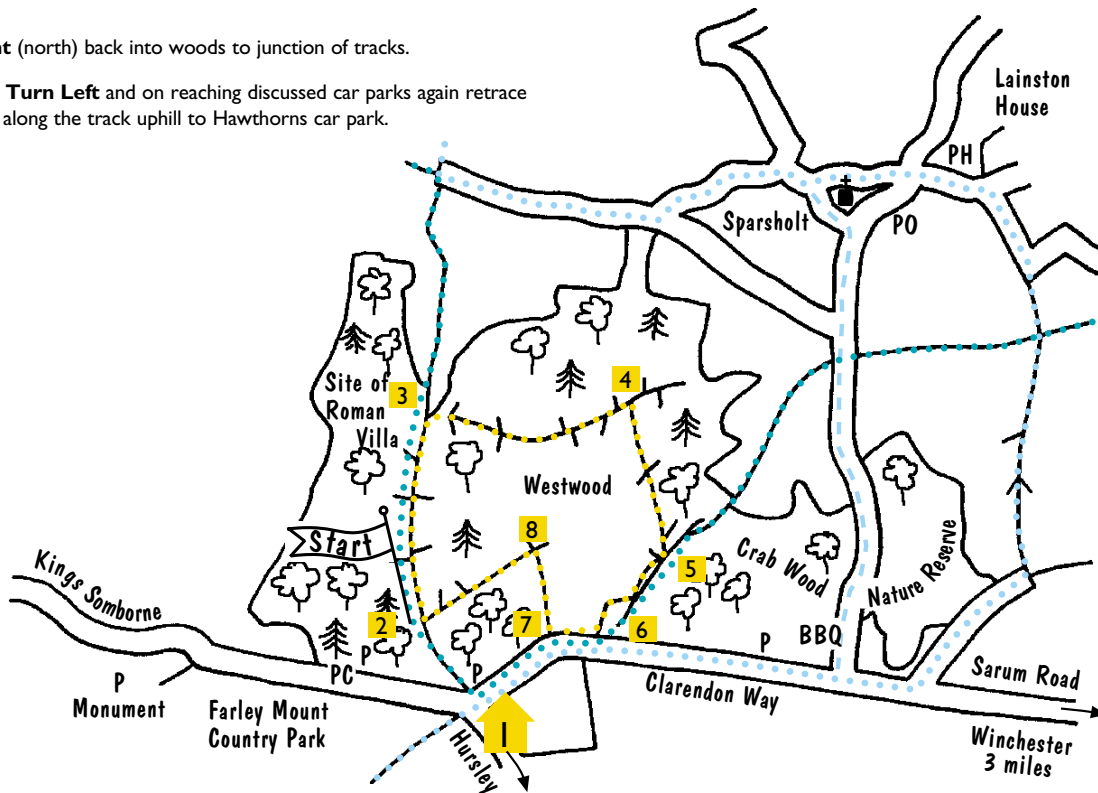

# WEST WOOD Off-Road Cycle Trail

A very safe route for a family outing, using tracks through attractive woodland. It is entirely off road within Farley Mount Country Park and is well signed with yellow route markers. The route is managed by Forest Enterprise which may need to make alterations to its own tracks according to Forest operations, but these will be signposted if they occur.

- 1** Start at Hawthorns car park at Farley Mount Country Park, 3 miles west of Winchester on the Sarum Road, off Chilbolton Avenue. (Grid ref. 414292). **Go past** the gate and down the track into the wood. **Continue** to the far end of the disused car parks at the bottom of the hill.
- 2** **Turn Left** along the forest track and continue **Straight Ahead** on the bridleway for about 1/2 mile.
- 3** At junction of tracks, leave bridleway and **Turn Right** onto track. Follow this track for 1/2 mile, ignoring all turns.
- 4** **Turn Right** following the mail forest track at this junction. **Cross Over** track Xroads.
- 5** **Bear Right** just before bridleway and continue on forest road heading southwest towards Sarum Road.
- 6** Just before Sarum Road **Turn Right** and ride parallel to the road for about 200 yards.
- 7** **Turn Right** (north) back into woods to junction of tracks.
- 8** At junction **Turn Left** and on reaching discussed car parks again retrace your route along the track uphill to Hawthorns car park.
