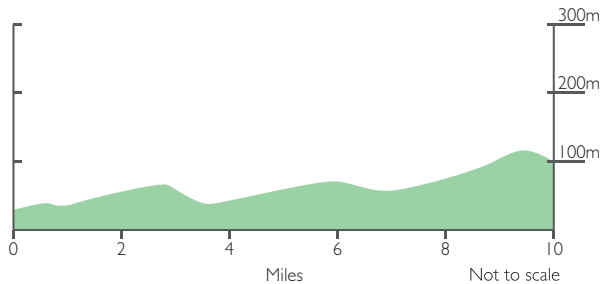

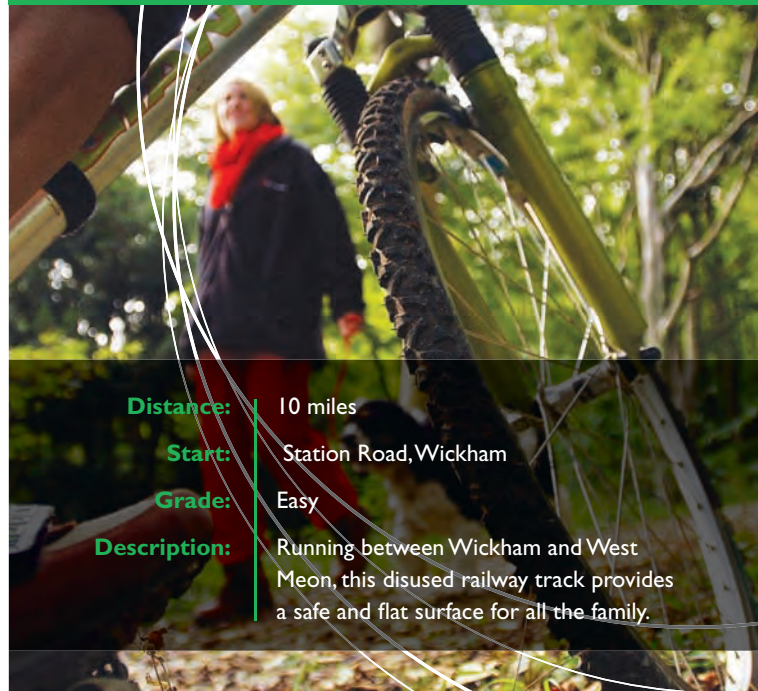

- 1 Start at Wickham car park next to the Trial just off of Station Close and cycle up on to the disused railway line.
- 2 Join the Meon Valley trial and continue north for 10 miles to West Meon.
- 3 Wickham is a picturesque village with a market square that once was home to a yearly fair that saw horses, pigs, cattle and sheep that could be bought but also known for its historical buildings.
