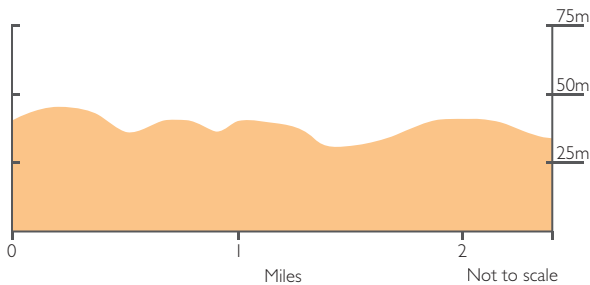

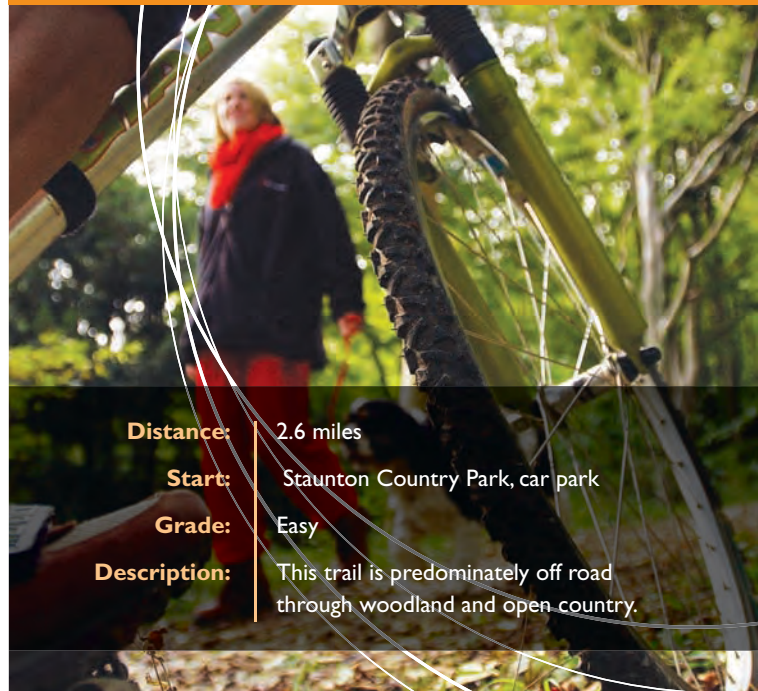

## Off Road Cycle Trails



- 1 From Staunton Country Park car park cross over road and enter Leigh Park Gardens continuing ahead on main gravel drive.
- 2 Take 1st track right leading you round in front of the Victorian Coach House, Continue past coach house bearing left before arriving at cross roads by picnic/play area.
- 3 Turn right onto Cedar Drive and continue ahead through woodland out onto track alongside Gypsies Plain.
- 4 Pass through gate and follow path left a short distance before passing through bridleway kissing gate onto grassy track running across Gypsies Plain.
- 5 On entering woodland turn left through gate and continue ahead rejoining gravel track.
- 6 Turn left at cross roads then take 1st path to your right leading you back to Cedar Drive track.
- 7 Turn right onto Cedar Drive and retrace your route back passed coach house and to car park.
