

## Who am I?

### What you need:

- Use images from the Living Album learning pack, Living Album website, or both. Access to a range of materials for drawing, painting, collage and modelling.

### Preparation:

- Pupils should have had some experience of working with a range of materials as outlined above.
- Print off images of people from the Living Album website and/or copy inserts from the Living Album learning pack as necessary. Choose a mix of paintings and photographs.

### Activity:

#### Stage 1

- Show pupils the images. Ask them to select or give them one each.
- Discuss briefly how the images were made i.e. painting, photograph.
- Encourage pupils to look closely at the image. What does the image portray about that person?
- What do any other objects in the picture infer about that person?
- Pupils can use the **Who am I?** Worksheet below to identify the information to support their findings.

#### Stage 2

- Explain to pupils that they are to make a portrait/image of that person in a different media using the range of materials you have provided.
- Ask pupils to include in their representation objects or other details that will convey further information about that person which may have been suggested in the original image.
- Encourage pupils to experiment with the materials available.
- Display the completed representations alongside the originals.

#### Additional activity:

- Pupils can write a simple report about the person their image represents, using details from the **Who am I?** Worksheet.
