


Railway line now open for walkers

Part of the old railway line is now open for public use as a footpath. The 1.3 mile stretch between South Charford (A) and Breamore (B), as shown on the map, has been cleared of vegetation by volunteers from the Ringwood and Fordingbridge Footpath Society and Breamore Parish Council. The New Forest National Park Authority has provided funding for the construction of a new bridge.

Further work still needs to be done to improve the line and it is hoped to extend the path southwards to Burgate Cross in 2011.
