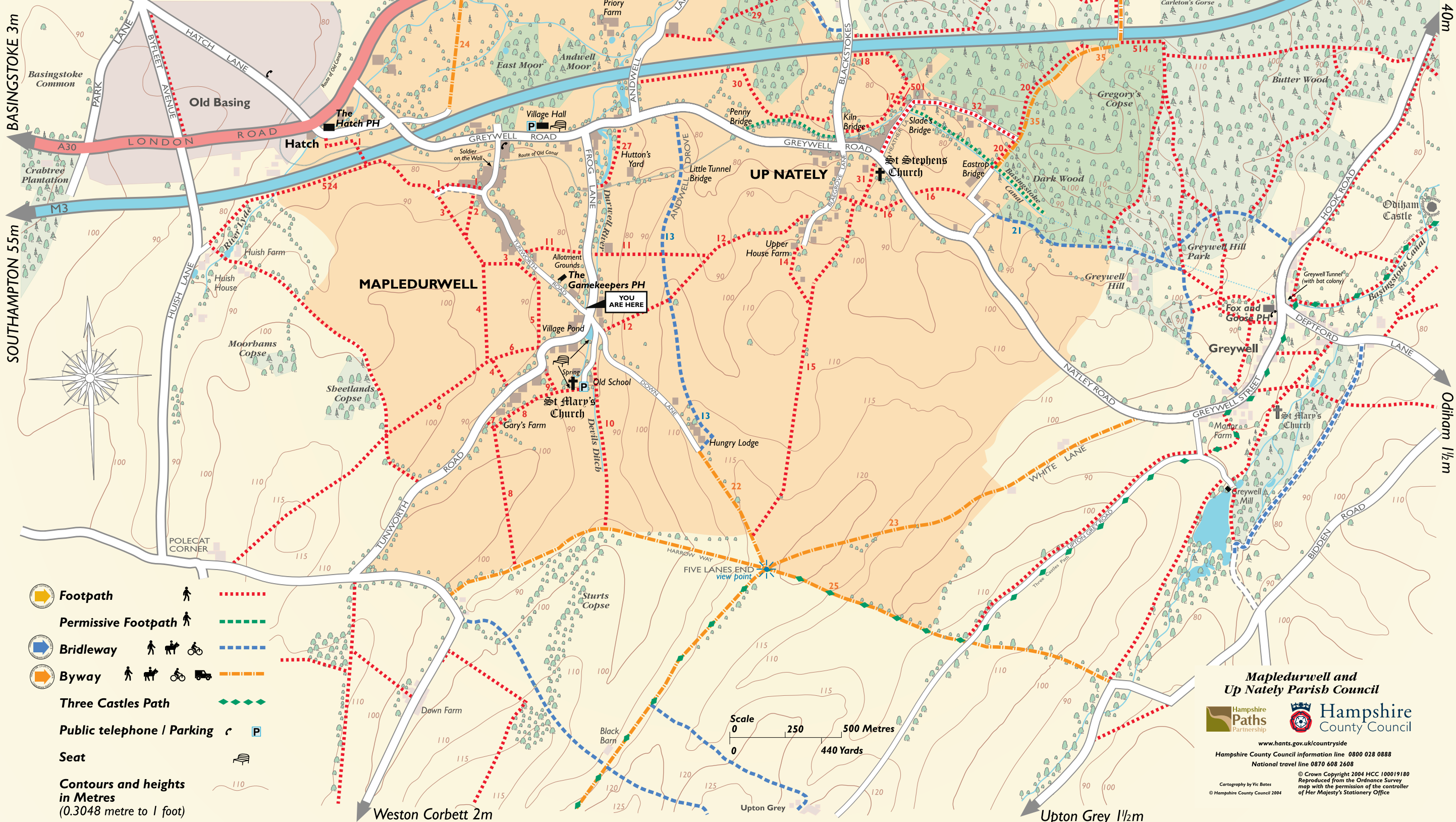
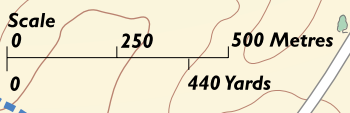


Welcome to MAPLEDURWELL & UP NATELY
