1. Summary

- 1.1. This report introduces two new members of the Management Committee who have been appointed since the last meeting.

2. Background

- 2.1 Following the appointment of David Jobson to the Harbour Board, a vacancy arose for the position of Berth and Mooring Holders Representative on the Management Committee. The vacancy was duly advertised and two candidates came forward. Dermod O'Malley was interviewed by a panel consisting of Councillors Woodward, Cartwright and Weston and subsequently appointed.
- 2.2 Councillor Allgood has been elected as Vice Chairman of the County Council and has therefore stood down from the Management Committee. The County Council has appointed Councillor Graham Burgess as his successor.
- 2.3 Dermod O'Malley is a Hamble resident and currently Rear Commodore (Sailing) of Hamble River Sailing Club. He is a mid-stream mooring holder.
- 2.4 Councillor Graham Burgess is the recently elected County Councillor for Lee-on-the-Solent.

- 3.1 Both new members have already attended training at the Harbour Office.
