ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE HAMPSHIRE (U218 LONDON ROAD, CLANFIELD) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2020

Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers and duties under Sections 1, 2, 3, 122(1) and 122(2) of the Act, and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following order:

1. In this order, and the preamble and schedule hereto:  
“the Act” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984  
“pedal cycle” means a unicycle, bicycle, tricycle, or cycle having four or more wheels, not being in any case mechanically propelled unless it is an electrically assisted pedal cycle of such class as is to be treated as not being a motor vehicle for the purposes of the 1984 Act; and  
“road” means any length of highway or any other length of road to which the public has access and includes bridges over which a road passes
2. Save as provided in article 3 of this order no person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed in that length of U218 London Road at Clanfield between a point 10 metres north-east of its junction with Whiteland Way and its north-eastern point of termination, an approximate distance of 90 metres.
3. Nothing in article 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in the length of road referred to in that article if the vehicle is:-
  - (a) a pedal cycle which is not a motor vehicle;
  - (b) for or in connection with the conveyance of goods or persons to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to any of those roads;
  - (c) being used in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to that length of road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in that length of road, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or telecommunications; or
  - (d) for fire, police or ambulance purposes.
4. This order shall come into operation on the *28 November* 2020 and may be cited as “The Hampshire (U218 London Road, Clanfield) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2020”.
