
THE HAMPSHIRE (WEST STREET, RINGWOOD)  
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2021

Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers and duties under Sections 1, 2, 3 and 122(1) and 122(2) of the Act, Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following order:

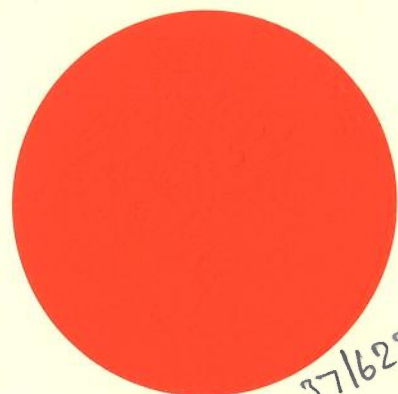
1. In this order, and the preamble and schedule hereto:  
  
“the Act” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984; and  
“road” means any length of highway or any other length of road to which the public has access and includes bridges over which a road may pass.
2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that road specified in the schedule to this order.
3. The Hampshire (Ringwood) (One-Way Traffic) Order 1966 shall be revoked insofar as it relates to Schedule I (Item 4) and Schedule II only.
4. This order shall come into operation on the 25<sup>th</sup> January 2021 and may be cited as “The Hampshire (West Street, Ringwood) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2021”.
