Please state the grounds on which they are made.

It may also be made public if the matter is referred to the Planning Inspectorate. It will become part of the permanent records kept on rights of way in Hampshire. The legal basis for our use of this information is the compliance with a legal obligation – Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs in whole or in part, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.

This Order is made by Hampshire County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that The Definitive Map Of Public Rights of Way and The Definitive Statement of Public Rights of Way (Dated 15th December 2007) requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Sections 53(3)(c)(i) and (ii) of the Act namely:-

c) the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows

- (i) That a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way to which this part applies;
- (ii) that a highway shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description;

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates.

Hampshire County Council hereby orders that:

1. For the purposes of the Order the relevant date is 26 November 2020.
2. The Hampshire Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way and The Hampshire Definitive Statement of Public Rights of Way (Dated 15th December 2007) shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule as shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The Hampshire (Test Valley Borough No. 68) (Parish of Andover and Parish of Longparish) Definitive Map Modification Order 2020.

Modifications of Definitive Map

Description of path or way to be added

From grid reference SU 3988 4562 to grid reference SU 4026 4617

A Bridleway 3 metres wide which commences at the C87 The Middleway and proceeds in a north-easterly direction to a junction with Longparish Footpath 27b, as shown between Points A – B on the Order map.

A total distance of 720 metres

Description of path or way to be upgraded

From grid reference SU 4026 4617 to grid reference SU 4027 4694

Part of Longparish Footpath 27b which commences at a junction with the above-mentioned Bridleway (Point B on the Order map) and proceeds in a northerly direction to the parish boundary at Point C.

A total distance of 21 metres

From grid reference SU 4027 4694 to grid reference SU 4027 4626

Part of Andover Footpath 68 which commences with the above Bridleway at the parish boundary (Point C on the Order map) and proceeds in a northerly direction to B3400 London Road at Point D.

A total distance of 63 metres

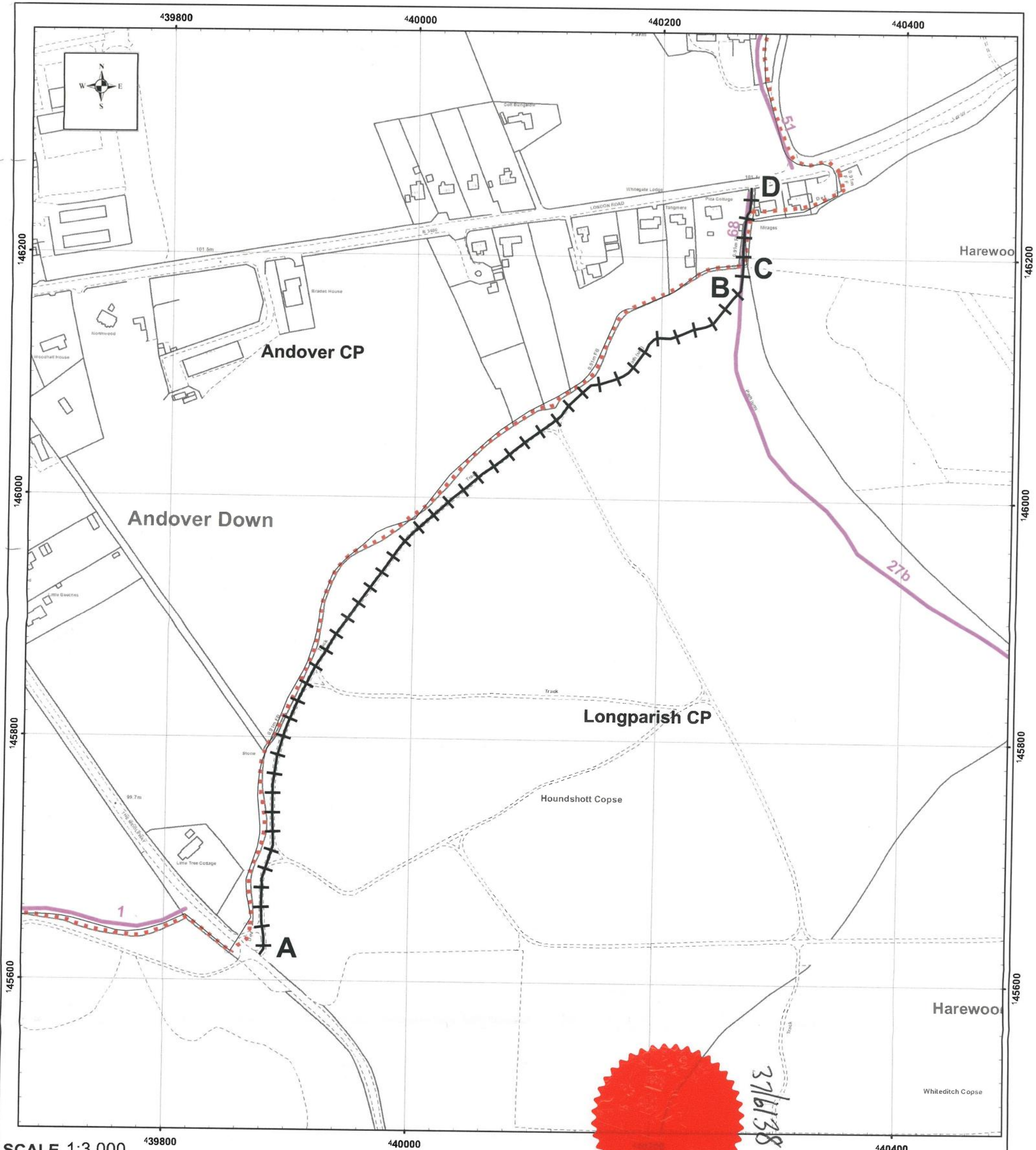
