

**THE HAMPSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS, RINGWOOD TO SOPLEY AREA)
(RESTRICTED ROAD, 30, 40 AND 50 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT)
ORDER 2021**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Hampshire County Council made the above-mentioned Orders on 23rd August 2021, in exercise of its powers and duties under the relevant Sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 “the Act”, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act and having discharged its duty under section 122 of the Act.

GENERAL NATURE AND EFFECTS OF THE ORDER: Will be to implement a 50mph speed limit on the following roads at Ringwood:

- U121 Kingston Service Road between its junction with the B3347 Christchurch Road and its junction with U121 Rod Lane.
- U121 Old Road Kingston between its junction with B3347 Christchurch Road and its junction with U121 Moorhouse Lane
- U121 Moorhouse Lane for its entire length.

DATE OF OPERATION: The order will come into force on 6th September 2021.

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Statement of Reasons

Following a review of the existing 50mph speed limit on the B3347 Christchurch Road/Ringwood Road, a couple of anomalies were noted in the Traffic Regulation Order. Therefore, Hampshire County Council proposes to implement a new 50mph speed limit on these roads.

The new speed limit will be supported by a review of the existing speed limit signing along the route.

ORDER 2021**

Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 82, 83 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. In this Order, and the preamble and schedule hereto :
 - “the Act” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
 - “mph” means miles per hour; and
 - “road” means any length of highway or any other length of road to which the public has access, and includes bridges over which a road passes.
 - “special forces” has the same meaning as defined in The Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011
2. The lengths of road specified in Schedule I to this Order shall be restricted roads for the purpose of Section 81 of the Act.
3. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 mph on any of the roads specified in the Schedule II to this Order.
4. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 mph on the road specified in the Schedule III to this Order.
5. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 mph on the road specified in the Schedule IV to this Order.
6. The following order is revoked in its entirety:

The Hampshire (B3347 Ringwood to Sopley Area) (Restricted Road, 30, 40 and 50 Miles per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2017
7. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
8. This order shall come into operation on *6th September* 2021 and may be cited as “The Hampshire (Various Roads, Ringwood to Sopley Area) (Restricted Road, 30, 40 and 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2021.”

SCHEDULE I

Roads in the District of New Forest Restricted Road (30 mph Speed Limit)

- (i) B3347 Mansfield Road between its roundabout junction with A31 Trunk Road (slip roads) and a point 9 metres north-west of its junction with Woodstock Lane, an approximate distance of 674 metres.
- (ii) C159 Southampton Road between its roundabout junction with B3347 Mansfield Road and a point 44 metres east thereof.
- (iii) C159 Southampton Road between a point 63.5 metres south-west of its junction with Parsonage Barn Lane and a point 95.4 metres east of its junction with Highfield Road, an approximate distance of 393 metres.
- (iv) C179 West Street between its junction with Market Place and its junction with A31 Trunk Road, an approximate distance of 343 metres.
- (v) Eastfield Lane / Hightown Road between its junction with Southampton Road Link (westbound) at A31 and its junction with Hightown Gardens, an approximate distance of 664 metres.
- (vi) Hightown Road between its junction with Eastfield Lane and its junction with Castleman Way, an approximate distance of 543 metres.
- (vii) B3347 Christchurch Road between a point 56 metres south of its junction with Willow Drive and a point 145 metres south of its junction with Hampshire Hatches Lane), an approximate distance of 600 metres.

SCHEDULE II

Roads in the District of New Forest 30 mph Speed Limit

- (i) Crow Lane between a point 291 metres north of its junction with Moortown Lane and its junction with Hightown Road (at Elm Tree Public House) and including the spur, an approximate distance of 745 metres.

- (ii) Crow Arch Lane between a point 20 metres south of its junction with Coniston Road and its junction with Crow Lane, an approximate distance of 799 metres.
- (iii) Hightown Road between a point 18 metres north-east of the eastern spur of Crow Lane and its junction with Hightown Gardens, an approximate distance of 113 metres north-west thereof.
- (iv) B3347 Ringwood Road between a point 511 metres south of Anna Lane and a point 272 metres south of its junction with London Lane, an approximate distance of 902 metres.
- (v) London Lane between its junction with B3347 Ringwood Road and a point 321 metres east thereof.
- (vi) North Ripley Road between a point 1,092 metres north of its junction with C213 Derritt Lane and a point 558 metres north of its junction with London Lane, an approximate distance of 833 metres.
- (vii) London Lane / Fish Street between the southernmost tip of its triangular junction with North Ripley Road and a point 299 metres west thereof, a total distance of 319 metres including both arms of its junction with North Ripley Road.
- (viii) Thatchers Lane (School Lane) between its junction with North Ripley Road and a point 185 metres east thereof.
- (ix) B3347 Ringwood Road between a point 375 metres south-east of its junction with the northern arm of C137 Avon Causeway and a point 545 metres south-east of that point.
- (x) B3347 Ringwood Road / Sopley Road (western leg) between a point 530 metres south-east of a point contiguous with the north-western boundary of the cemetery and its junction with Mill Lane, an approximate distance of 350 metres.
- (xi) B3347 Sopley Road (eastern leg) between its junction with B3347 Ringwood Road and its junction with Mill Lane, an approximate distance of 250 metres.
- (xii) B3347 Salisbury Road between its junction with B3347 Sopley Road and a point 180 metres south thereof.
- (xiii) C213 Derritt Lane between its junction with B3347 Sopley Road (aka Salisbury Road) and a point 450 metres east thereof.
- (xiv) Mill Lane, Sopley between its junction with B3347 Sopley Road (aka Salisbury Road) and a point 100 metres south thereof.
- (xv) Priest Lane, Sopley between its junction with B3347 Sopley Road (aka Salisbury Road) and a point 250 metres north thereof.

SCHEDULE III

Roads in the District of New Forest 40 mph Speed Limit

- (i) B3347 Christchurch Road between a point 145m south of its junction with Hampshire Hatches Lane and a point 375 metres south of that point.
- (ii) U121 Nouale Lane between its junction with C49 Southampton Road Link and its junction with C179 Hightown Road / Hightown Hill, an approximate distance of 735 metres.
- (iii) C49 Crow Lane between its junction with Moortown Lane and a point 291 metres north thereof.
- (iv) C104 Moortown Lane / Ringwood Road between a point 10 metres east of its junction with B3347 and its junction with C10 north of Burley Street, an approximate distance of 4,670 metres.
- (v) U121 Green Lane between its junction with C104 Moortown Lane and its junction with C115 Long Lane, an approximate distance of 730 metres.
- (vi) U121 Streets Lane between its junction with U121 Green Lane and its junction with C49 Ringwood Road at Crow, an approximate distance of 290 metres.
- (vii) U121 Barrack Lane between its junction with C49 Ringwood Road and its junction with C104 Moortown Lane, an approximate distance of 1,050 metres.
- (viii) C115 Long Lane between its junction with C104 Moortown Road and its junction with C49 Ringwood Road at North Kingston, an approximate distance of 1,490 metres.
- (ix) Charles Lane between its junction with C49 at Stocks Green / North Kingston (including link) and its junction with C104 at Knaves Ash, an approximate distance of 2,488 metres.
- (x) U121 Rod Lane between its junction with B3347 at Kingston Villas and its junction with C115 Long Lane at North Kingston, an approximate distance of 1,140 metres.
- (xi) U121 Charles's Lane between its junction with C49 Ringwood Road and its junction with C104 Moortown Lane, an approximate distance of 2,500 metres.
- (xii) U121 Bagnum Lane between its junction with U121 Charles's Lane and the end of the public highway near Bagnum Farm, an approximate distance of 800 metres.
- (xiii) U121 Brixeyes between its junction with U121 Dragon Lane and the end of the public highway near Brixey's Farm, an approximate distance of 270 metres.
