

THE HAMPSHIRE (GORDON ROAD, FARNBOROUGH) (EXPERIMENTAL SUSPENSION OF ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Hampshire County Council made the above-mentioned Order on Tuesday 2nd July 2024, in exercise of its powers and duties under Sections 9, 10(1), 10(2), 122(1) and 122(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, and having discharged its duty under section 122 of the Act.

GENERAL NATURE AND EFFECTS OF THE ORDER: Will, for a period of 18 months, suspend the existing one-way restriction on Gordon Road so that it will become normal two-way traffic. This will also impose a prohibition of waiting on the south side of Gordon Road from a point 15 metres east of its Junction with Peabody Road to a point 15 metres west of its junction with Morris Road. That part of Schedule One which mentions Gordon Road in “Rushmoor Borough Council (One-Way Streets and Other Prescribed Directions, Farnborough) (Consolidation) Order 2013.” will be part-suspended for the duration of this order and The Rushmoor Borough Council (Various Roads in Farnborough) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and on street parking places) (Farnborough Consolidation) (C0021) Order 2021 will be varied to accommodate the prohibition of waiting.

DATE OF OPERATION: The order will come into force on Monday 15th July 2024 and will continue in force until 15th January 2026.

THE HAMPSHIRE (MORRIS ROAD, FARNBOROUGH) (EXPERIMENTAL SUSPENSION OF ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Hampshire County Council made the above-mentioned Order on Tuesday 2nd July 2024, in exercise of its powers and duties under Sections 9, 10(1), 10(2), 122(1) and 122(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, and having discharged its duty under section 122 of the Act.

GENERAL NATURE AND EFFECTS OF THE ORDER: Will, for a period of 18 months, vary the existing one-way restriction on Morris Road so that it will become normal two-way traffic from a point 17 metres north of its junction with Lynchford road and its junction with Gordon Road. That part of Schedule One which mentions Morris Road in “Rushmoor Borough Council (One-Way Streets and Other Prescribed Directions, Farnborough) (Consolidation) Order 2013.” will be amended to allow two-way traffic flow as stated above for the duration of this order.

DATE OF OPERATION: The order will come into force on Monday 15th July 2024 and will continue in force until 15th January 2026.

THE HAMPSHIRE (GORDON ROAD, FARNBOROUGH) (EXPERIMENTAL SUSPENSION OF ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

Statement of Reasons

In June 2023, Hampshire County Council's Executive Lead Member for Economy, Transport and Environment approved a temporary traffic order to suspend the one-way restriction on Gordon Road between Morris Road and Peabody Road for the duration of the works on Lynchford Road. Additionally, the order included the suspension of parking on Gordon Road (Southern side), Farnborough, Rushmoor between its junction with Morris Road and its junction with Peabody Road.

This Experimental Traffic Regulation Order is being made to explore the possibility of retaining these provisions on a permanent basis. The general proposals and effects of this order are to suspend:

- a) The one-way restrictions on Gordon Road, Farnborough, Rushmoor between Morris Road and Peabody Road.
- b) One-way restriction on Morris Road, Farnborough, Rushmoor between its junction with Gordon Road and a position approximately 17m north of its junction with Lynchford Road.

The reasons for these proposals are to (i) facilitate improved access for businesses on this section of Lynchford Road to the rear of their premises for deliveries following completion of the upgraded footway and cycleway on Lynchford Road and (ii) to increase network resilience in the event of disruption on Lynchford Road.

Statement of Reasons

Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers and duties under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 9, 10(1), 10(2), and 122(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following order:

1. In this order:
The Moving Order means “Rushmoor Borough Council (One-Way Streets and Other Prescribed Directions, Farnborough) (Consolidation) Order 2013.”
The Parking Order means “The Rushmoor Borough Council (Various Roads in Farnborough) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and on street parking places) (Farnborough Consolidation) (C0021) Order 2021”
2. Article 2 and The First Schedule (one-way traffic) in the Moving Order shall have effect as though the item specified below is hereby suspended:
Gordon Road
From its junction with Morris Road in a westerly direction to its junction with Peabody Road
3. Schedule 3.03 (waiting prohibited between 8.30am and 6.00pm Mondays to Saturdays inclusive) in the Parking Order shall have effect as though the item specified below is hereby suspended:
Gordon Road
South Side
From a point 15 metres east of its junction with Peabody Road to a point 15 metres west of its junction with Morris Road
And that the following item were inserted into Schedule 1.06 (no waiting at any time) of the Parking Order:
Gordon Road
South Side
From a point 15 metres east of its Junction with Peabody Road to a point 15 metres west of its junction with Morris Road
4. The Director of Universal Services as the authorised officer pursuant to section 10(2) of the Act, may if it appears essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic on the highway or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the Order runs, modify or suspend the order or any of its provisions.
5. This order shall come into force on *Monday 15th July* 2024 and continue in force until *Thursday 15th January* 2026 and may be cited as

“The Hampshire (Gordon Road, Farnborough) (Experimental Prohibition of Waiting and Suspension of One-Way Traffic) Order 2024”.

1. In this order:
The Principal Order means “Rushmoor Borough Council (One Way Streets and Other Prescribed Directions, Farnborough) (Consolidation) Order 2013.”
2. The First Schedule (one-way traffic) in the Principal Order shall effect as though the item:
Morris Road
From its Junction with A3011 Lynchford Road in a northerly direction to its junction with High Street
Is hereby replaced with:
Morris Road
Between its junction with A3011 Lynchford Road in a northerly direction and a point 17 metres north of that point.
Morris Road
From its junction with Gordon Road in a northerly direction to its junction with High Street.
3. The Director of Universal Services as the authorised officer pursuant to section 10(2) of the Act, may if it appears essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic on the highway or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the Order runs, modify or suspend the order or any of its provisions.
4. This order shall come into force on *Monday 15th July* 2024 and continue in force until *Thursday 15th January* 2026 and may be cited as “The Hampshire (Morris Road, Farnborough) (Experimental One-Way Traffic) Order 2024”.
