The above named Order made on 8 November 2024, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by recording a restricted byway, commencing at a junction with the B3335 where Cox's Hill meets Winchester Road, proceeding in a north-easterly direction for approximately 234 metres to a junction with Twyford Restricted Byway 16.

Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Head of Countryside Access, Hampshire County Council, Castle Avenue, Winchester, SO23 8UL, or via the internet to row.notices@hants.gov.uk quoting reference:- DMMO 1179 no later than 10 January 2025. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

The personal data you provide in any representation will be treated in accordance with Data Protection Legislation. We will only use the information you provide in connection with the determination of this Order. It may be made public if the matter is referred to the Planning Inspectorate. It will become part of the permanent records kept on rights of way in Hampshire. The legal basis for our use of this information is the compliance with a legal obligation – Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs in whole or in part, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.

This Order is made by Hampshire County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that The Definitive Map Of Public Rights of Way and The Definitive Statement of Public Rights of Way (Dated 15th December 2007) requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3) of the Act namely:-

c) the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows

- (i) that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a restricted byway

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates.

Hampshire County Council hereby orders that:

1. For the purposes of the Order the relevant date is 29th October 2024
2. The Hampshire Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way and The Hampshire Definitive Statement of Public Rights of Way (Dated 15th December 2007) shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule as shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The Hampshire (City of Winchester No.56) (Parish of Twyford) Definitive Map Modification Order 2024.

From grid reference SU 4816 2572 to grid reference SU 4838 2580

A new restricted byway, commencing at a junction with B3335 and proceeding along an enclosed track in an east-north-east direction to a junction with Twyford Restricted Byway 16, running between points A and B on the accompanying order map.

Varying between 6 and 8 metres in width, as shown by grey shading on the Order map accompanying The Hampshire (City of Winchester No.56) (Parish of Twyford) Definitive Map Modification Order 2024.

A total length of 234 metres.

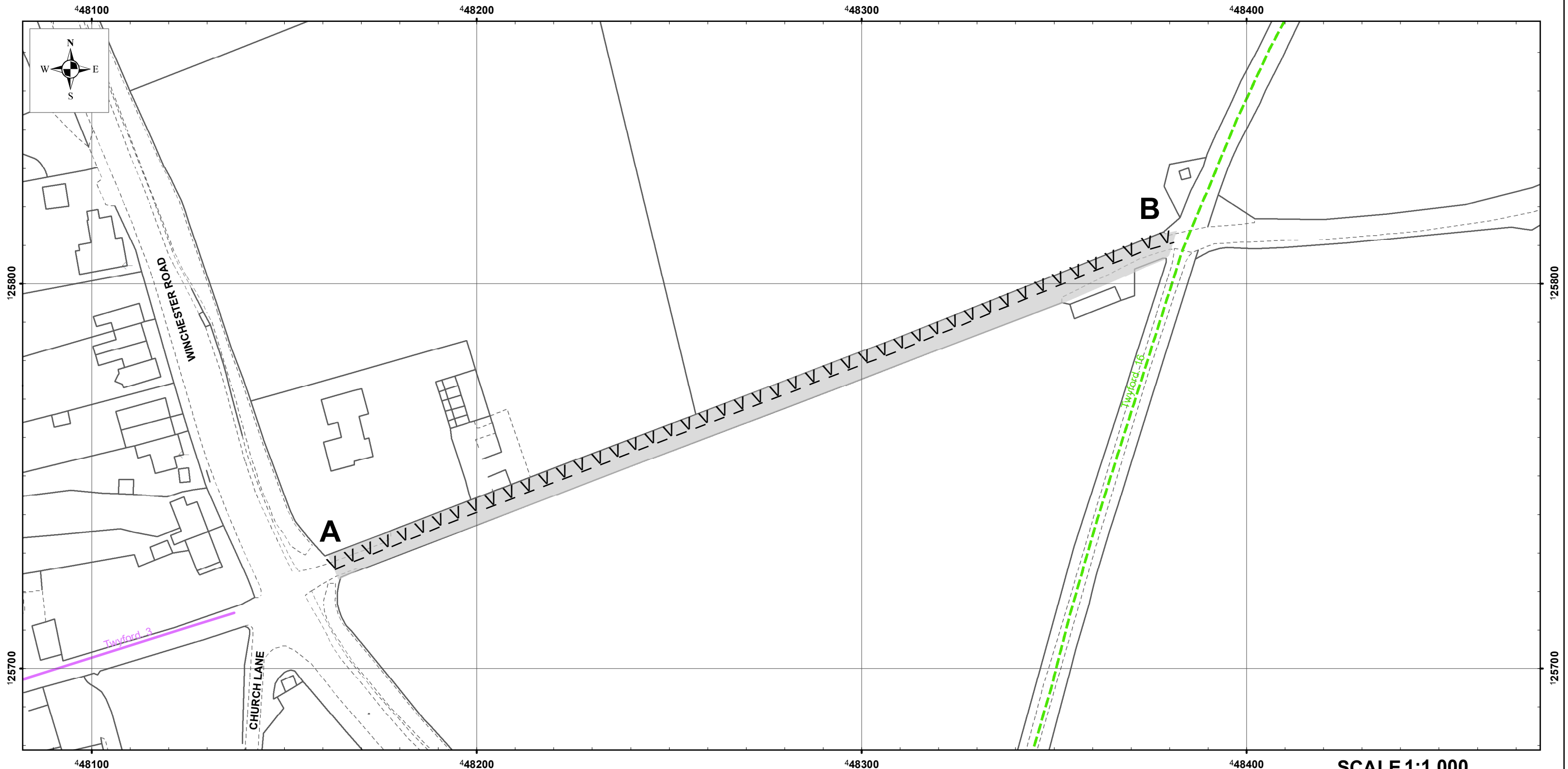
