

TRAFFIC ORDER PROPOSALS – PROHIBITION OF WAITING ON BROOK LANE AND FAREHAM COMMUNITY HOSPITAL ACCESS ROAD

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Hampshire County Council (“the Council”) proposes to make the above-mentioned Order, in exercise of its powers and duties under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“The Act”), Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act and having discharged its duty under section 122 of the Act.

GENERAL NATURE AND EFFECTS OF THE ORDER: As a part of the Hampshire County Councils Zebra Crossing scheme, it will be necessary to implement a new Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) to amend some of the existing parking restrictions on Brook Lane by changing the existing single yellow lines to double yellow lines to prevent the impediment of sight lines at the two new crossings and obstruction from potential parked vehicles adjacent to the three proposed traffic islands. Also, the existing double yellow lines on Fareham Community Hospital Access Road will be formalised within this TRO.

The order will be to implement No Waiting at any Time restrictions as described in the following schedule:

NO WAITING AT ANY TIME

ROAD	SIDE	LENGTH
Brook lane	Both	Between a point 115 metres south of the roundabout at the junction of Bridge Road (A27) and the roundabout junction of Headland Drive.
Fareham Community Hospital Access Road	Both	Between its junction with Brook Lane and its western end including the roundabout.

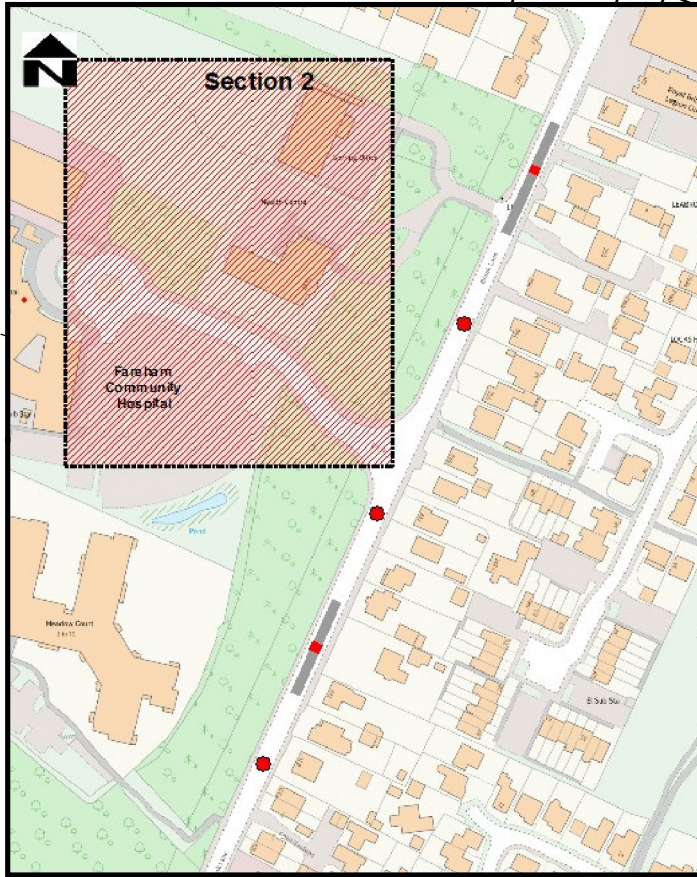

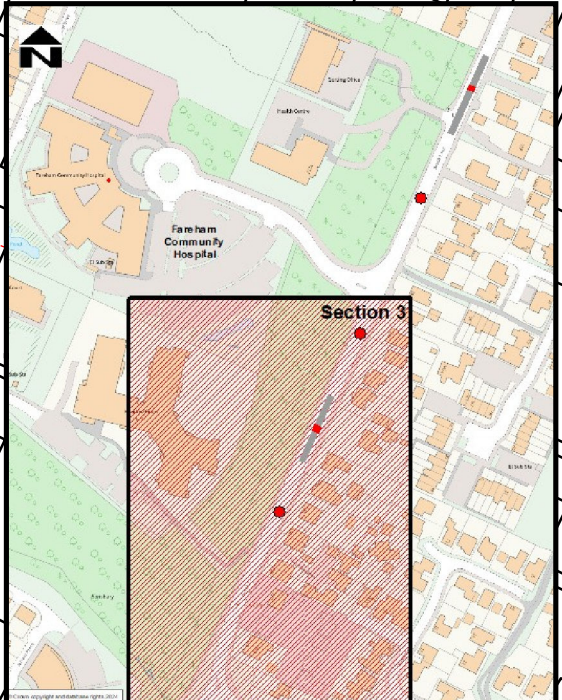

THE HAMPSHIRE (FAREHAM) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2023 (VARIATION NO. 12) (BROOK LANE, FAREHAM) ORDER 2026

Statement of Reasons

Hampshire County Council are currently working on a proposed scheme which aims to provide improved pedestrian crossing facilities on Brook Lane to ensure safe access to key destinations, including Fareham Community Hospital, Brook Lane GP Surgery, and the Royal Mail Sarisbury Green Delivery Office. The proposed crossings are strategically located to encourage use of the wider eastern footway and to provide safer, more convenient access to local facilities. This approach aligns with Local Transport Plan 4 (LTP4) objectives and the Council's commitment to promoting sustainable modes of transport.

The scheme is sited on Brook Lane between the roundabouts leading to Headlands Drive/Lockswood Road and Station Road/Bridge Road (A27).

As a part of this scheme, it will be necessary to implement a new Traffic Regulation Order to amend some of the existing parking restrictions by changing the existing single yellow lines to double yellow lines to prevent the impediment of sight lines at the new crossings and obstruction from potential parked vehicles adjacent to the proposed traffic islands. The new double yellow lines will prohibit parking at all times, maintaining clear approaches to crossings and traffic calming features, which are essential to the new schemes aims of reducing speeds and improving pedestrian safety.

Converting the existing single yellow lines to double yellow lines is integral to the success of the proposed pedestrian safety scheme. It ensures unobstructed visibility, consistent traffic flow, and a safer environment for all road users. New road markings as per the attached plans will indicate the proposed restrictions.

We will also be taking the opportunity to address some minor anomalies in parking restrictions that we have encountered in the area.

HAMPSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE HAMPSHIRE (FAREHAM) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PARKING PLACES) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2023

Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers and duties under sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53, 122 (1) and 122 (2) of the Act, Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling and amending legislation and powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

PART 1 GENERAL

Citation and commencement

1. This Order shall come into operation on Monday 31st July 2023 and may be cited as The Hampshire (Fareham) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2023.
2. The map schedules attached hereto in Schedule 7 ("the map schedules") are incorporated into this Order.
3. The traffic regulation orders imposing waiting prohibitions and restrictions and all on street parking places orders which relate to roads in the Borough of Fareham made prior to this Order and listed in Schedule 1 to this Order are hereby revoked. This Order consolidates all the contents of those orders in this Order.

Definitions

4. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:
 - "the Act" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
 - "the Council" means Hampshire County Council
 - "the Regulations of 2016" means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016
 - "Area identifier" means an alpha and or alpha/numeric identifier specified in Column 1 of Schedule 3, applicable to the type of parking places specified in Column 2, which indicates the Residents Parking Area specified in Column 3 and is used on permits to identify the permit parking places for which they are valid and on signs at relevant parking places and in the map tile labels and/or map schedule legend in the map schedule to indicate the permits valid at those parking places;
 - "Business Visitor Permit" shall mean a permit issued to businesses which comply with the conditions listed in Article 37;

- (c) the provisions of the Act as amended shall apply to the disposal of any such Vehicle removed by or on behalf of the Council pursuant to this Article.

Nothing in this Article shall apply in respect of a Vehicle displaying in the Relevant Position a valid Disabled Person's Badge issued by any local authority.

Derogation and Precedence over other Orders

- 74. (1) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
- (2) Where the provisions of any order made or having effect as if made under the Act which imposes any prohibition or restriction on waiting by Vehicles or grant any exemption from such prohibition or restriction relate to a length of road designated as a Parking Place in this Order the provisions of this Order shall prevail.
