

**THE HAMPSHIRE (GORDON ROAD AND MORRIS ROAD, FARNBOROUGH)  
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND REVOCATION AND VARIATION OF ONE-WAY  
TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Hampshire County Council made the above-mentioned Order on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> December 2025, in exercise of its powers and duties under Sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, and having discharged its duty under section 122 of the Act.

**GENERAL NATURE AND EFFECTS OF THE ORDER:** will be combine and to make permanent the provisions of the “The Hampshire (Gordon Road, Farnborough) (Experimental Prohibition of Waiting and Suspension of One-Way Traffic) Order 2024” and “The Hampshire (Morris Road, Farnborough) (Experimental One-Way Traffic) Order 2024”.

These orders had the effect of restoring normal two-way traffic on Gordon Road and to convert the existing No Waiting between 8.30am and 6pm on the south side of Gordon Road into No Waiting at Any Time to accommodate the two-way Traffic and to restore normal two-way traffic on Morris Road between a point 17 metres north of its junction with Lynchford Road and its junction with high street, which would retain the current no entry sign but allow access to Gordon Road from Morris Road.

*This permanent order would combine the two orders to revoke the one-way provisions as they appear in the principal orders and to amend the No Waiting restrictions as reflected in the above named orders.*

**DATE OF OPERATION:** The order will come into force on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> February 2026

**APPLICATION TO THE HIGH COURT:** Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Act, or that any of the relevant requirements of the Act or of any relevant instrument made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, by Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2026 make application for the purpose to the High Court.

## **THE HAMPSHIRE (GORDON ROAD, FARNBOROUGH) (EXPERIMENTAL SUSPENSION OF ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024**

### Statement of Reasons

In June 2023, Hampshire County Council's Executive Lead Member for Economy, Transport and Environment approved a temporary traffic order to suspend the one-way restriction on Gordon Road between Morris Road and Peabody Road for the duration of the works on Lynchford Road. Additionally, the order included the suspension of parking on Gordon Road (Southern side), Farnborough, Rushmoor between its junction with Morris Road and its junction with Peabody Road.

This Experimental Traffic Regulation Order is being made to explore the possibility of retaining these provisions on a permanent basis. The general proposals and effects of this order are to suspend:

- a) The one-way restrictions on Gordon Road, Farnborough, Rushmoor between Morris Road and Peabody Road.
- b) One-way restriction on Morris Road, Farnborough, Rushmoor between its junction with Gordon Road and a position approximately 17m north of its junction with Lynchford Road.

The reasons for these proposals are to (i) facilitate improved access for businesses on this section of Lynchford Road to the rear of their premises for deliveries following completion of the upgraded footway and cycleway on Lynchford Road and (ii) to increase network resilience in the event of disruption on Lynchford Road.

#### THE HAMPSHIRE (GORDON ROAD AND MORRIS ROAD, FARNBOROUGH) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND REVOCATION AND VARIATION OF ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers and duties under Sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 9 and 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), Part IV of Section 9 to the Act, and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following order:

1. In this order:  
The Moving Order means “Rushmoor Borough Council (One-Way Streets and Other Prescribed Directions, Farnborough) (Consolidation) Order 2013.”  
The Parking Order means “The Rushmoor Borough Council (Various Roads in Farnborough) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and on street parking places) (Farnborough Consolidation) (C0021) Order 2021”
2. Article 2 and The First Schedule (one-way traffic) in the Moving Order shall have effect as though the items specified below was deleted:  
**Gordon Road**  
From its junction with Morris Road in a westerly direction to its junction with Peabody Road  
**Morris Road**  
From its Junction with A3011 Lynchford Road in a northerly direction to its junction with High Street
3. Article 2 and The First Schedule (one-way traffic) in the Moving Order shall have effect as though the items specified below were inserted:  
**Morris Road**  
Between its junction with A3011 Lynchford Road in a northerly direction and a point 17 metres north of that point.  
**Morris Road**  
From its junction with Gordon Road in a northerly direction to its junction with High Street.
4. Schedule 3.03 (waiting prohibited between 8.30am and 6.00pm Mondays to Saturdays inclusive) in the Parking Order shall have effect as though the item specified below were deleted:  
**Gordon Road**  
South Side  
From a point 15 metres east of its junction with Peabody Road to a point 15 metres west of its junction with Morris Road

4. Schedule 2.01 of The Parking Order shall have effect as though the item specified below were inserted:

**Gordon Road**

South Side

From a point 15 metres east of its Junction with Peabody Road to a point 15 metres west of its junction with Morris Road

5. The following orders are hereby revoked in their entirety:

(i) The Hampshire (Gordon Road, Farnborough) (Experimental Prohibition of Waiting and Suspension of One-Way Traffic) Order 2024

(ii) The Hampshire (Morris Road, Farnborough) (Experimental Two-Way Traffic) Order 2024

5. This order shall come into force on *Monday 12<sup>th</sup> January* 2025 and may be cited as "The Hampshire (Gordon Road and Morris Road, Farnborough) (Prohibition of Waiting and Revocation and Variation of One-Way Traffic) Order 2025".

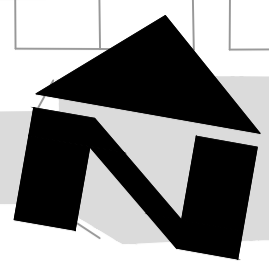
