

THE HAMPSHIRE (OAKCROFT LANE AND RANVILLES LANE, FAREHAM) (30 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Hampshire County Council made the above-mentioned Order on Tuesday 19th May 2026, in exercise of its powers and duties under Sections 84 and 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, and having discharged its duty under section 122 of the Act.

GENERAL NATURE AND EFFECTS OF THE ORDER: Will be to implement a 30 miles per hour speed limit on Oakcroft Lane and adjacent roads, as follows:

- (i) Oakcroft Lane between its junction with Ranvilles Lane and its junction with The Poplars, an approximate distance of 510 metres.
- (ii) Ranvilles Lane between its junction with Farm House Close and its junction with Oakcroft Lane, an approximate distance of 160 metres.
- (iii) The Poplars, for its entire length.

The Poplars will become 30 miles per hour by virtue of section 82(1)(a) of the Act, with no requirement for an Order.

DATE OF OPERATION: The order will come into force on Saturday 30th May 2026.

THE HAMPSHIRE (OAKCROFT LANE AND RANVILLES LANE, FAREHAM)
(30 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026

Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers and duties under Sections 84 and 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following order:

1. In this order, and the preamble and schedule hereto:

“the Act” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

“mph” means miles per hour;

“road” means any length of highway or any other length of road to which the public has access, and includes bridges over which a road passes; and

“special forces” has the same meaning as defined in The Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011

2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 mph on any of those roads specified in the schedule to this order.
3. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
4. This order shall come into force on *Saturday 30th May* 2026 and may be cited as “The Hampshire (Oakcroft Lane and Ranvilles Lane, Fareham) (30 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2026.”

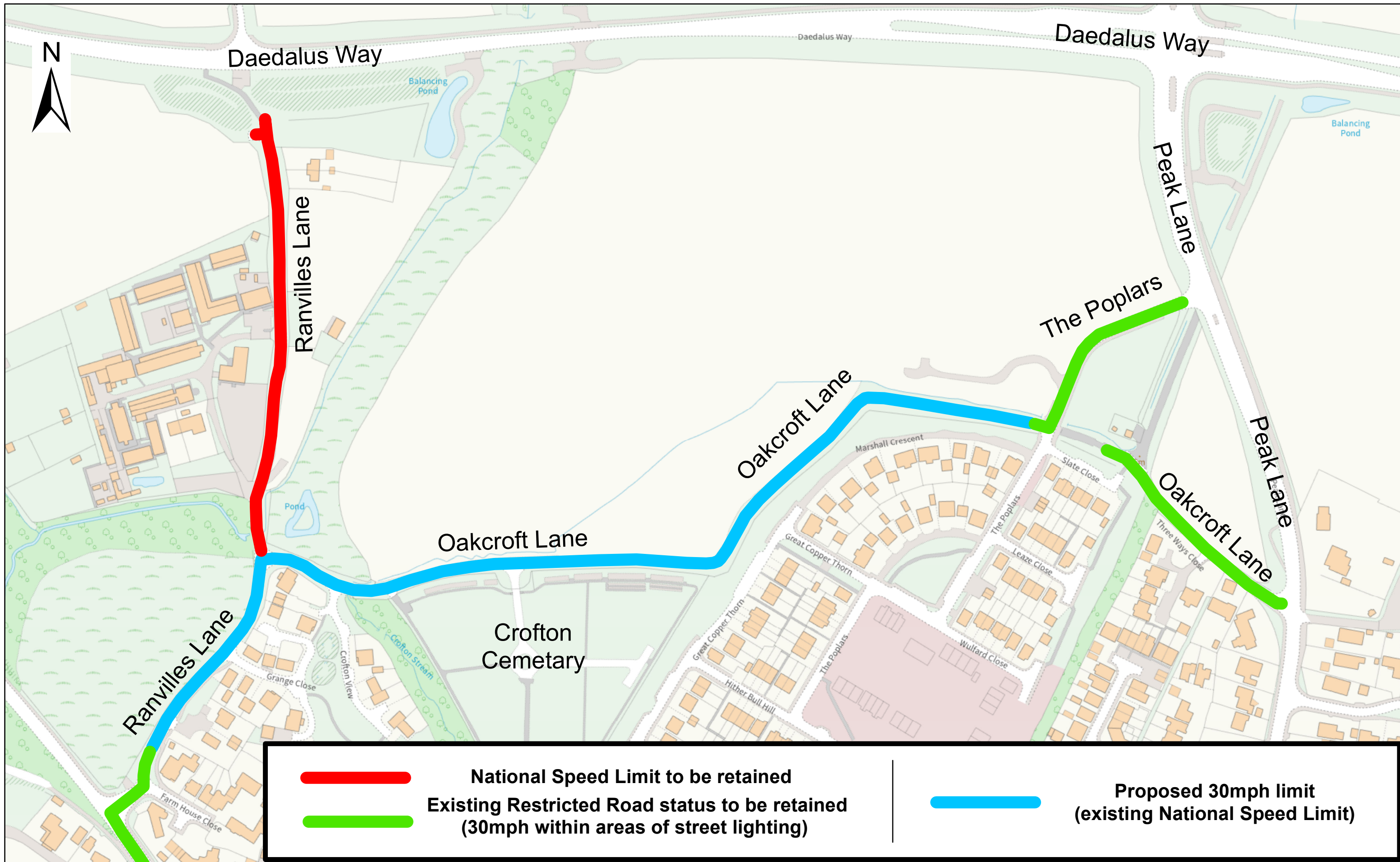

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Hampshire County Council proposes to implement a Traffic Regulation Order to introduce a new 30mph speed limit on Oakcroft Lane.

As part of the Planning consents for two residential developments on Oakcroft Lane, planning conditions were imposed that a 30mph speed limit should be considered alongside each of the new developments. To provide more consistency for all road users, it is intended to extend the 30mph limit throughout the whole route, not just alongside the new access points to each site. This will also be consistent with sections of existing 30mph Restricted Road status within areas of street lighting at each end of the route, as well as complying with Department for Transport design guidance related to minimum lengths of speed limits.

National speed limit (60mph) is currently in place on this section of route, and reducing the speed limit to 30mph will better suit the new residential characteristics. The reduced speed limit will also enhance safety for the increased numbers of all road users, including children and vulnerable road users, who will be accessing the new residential developments, as well as promoting active travel and aligning with the principles of creating a safer, more liveable community environment.

Description of proposed 30mph speed limit (existing National Speed Limit)

Ranvilles Lane	Between its junction with Farmhouse Close/Ranvilles Lane to its junction with Oakcroft Lane approximately 160 metres
Oakcroft Lane	Between its junction with Ranvilles Lane to its junction with The Poplars approximately 510 metres
