

## **TRAFFIC ORDER PROPOSALS – PROHIBITION OF DRIVING ON BRAMSHOT LANE, FARNBOROUGH**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Hampshire County Council (“the Council”) proposes to make the above-mentioned Order, in exercise of its powers and duties under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act and having discharged its duty under section 122 of the Act.

**GENERAL NATURE AND EFFECTS OF THE ORDER:** Will be to prohibit motor vehicles from driving along Bramshot Lane between its junction with Minley Road and a point 228 metres west of that point where it becomes a public bridleway.

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**THE HAMPSHIRE (BRAMSHOT LANE, FARNBOROUGH) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2026**

Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers and duties under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 122 of the Act, and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following order:

1. In this order, and the preamble and schedule hereto:  
“the Act” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;  
“vehicle” includes part of a vehicle;  
“causing” means permitting;  
“road” means any length of highway or any other length of road to which the public has access and includes bridges over which a road may pass.
2. Save as in Article 3 of this order no person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed in that length of road specified in the schedule to this order.
3. Nothing in Article 2 above shall apply if that vehicle is:
  - (i) being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue services;
  - (ii) being used for maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of said length of road;
4. This order shall come into force on the \_\_\_\_\_ 2026 and may be cited as “The Hampshire (Bramshot Lane, Farnborough) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2026”.

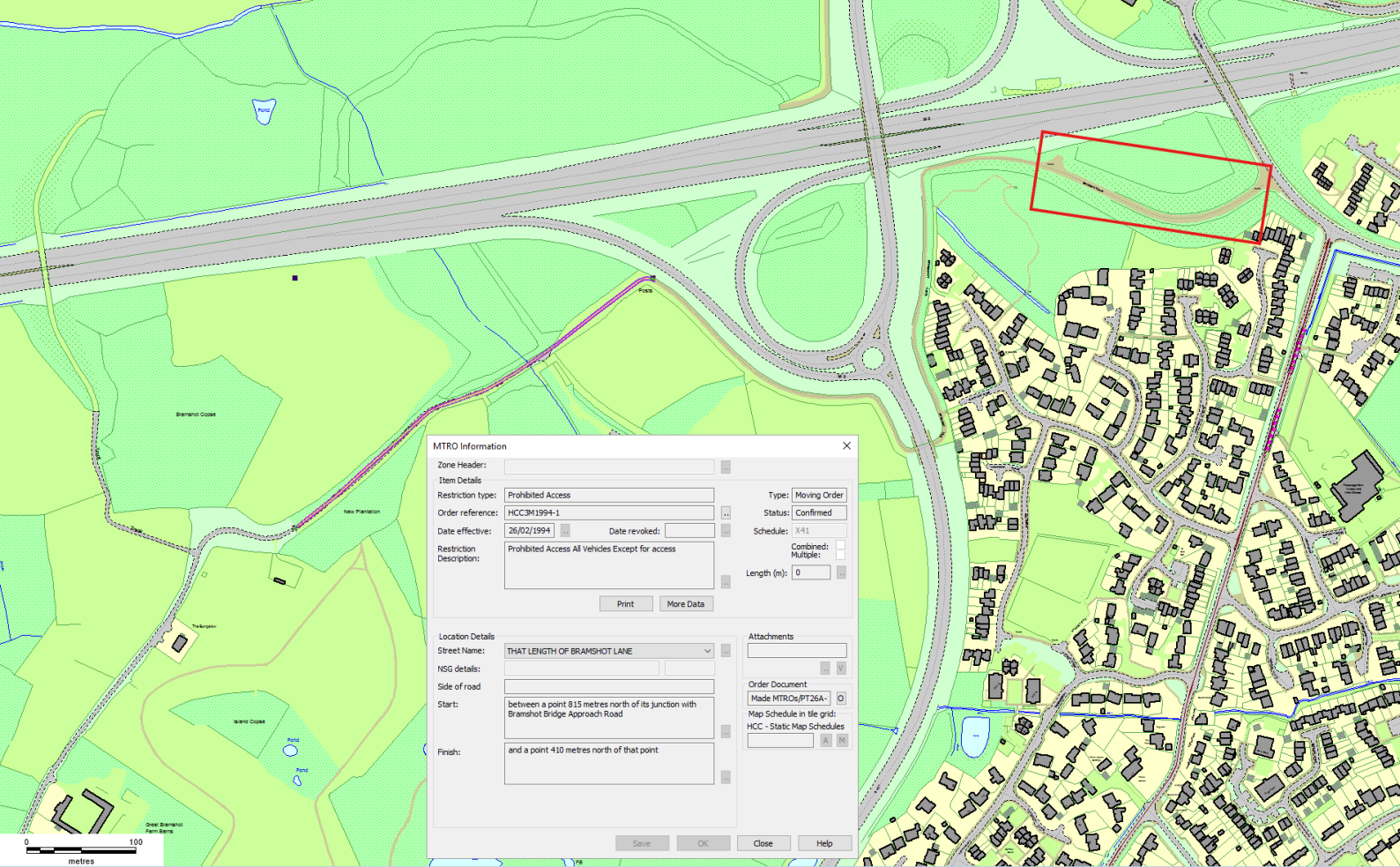

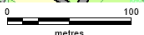

**THE HAMPSHIRE (BRAMSHOT LANE, FARNBOROUGH)  
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2026**

**Statement of Reasons**

Bramshot Lane is a narrow, single lane carriageway, which becomes a bridleway after 228 metres from its junction with Minley Road.

Currently it is a road which is designed to discourage the use of motor vehicles, however at this current point in time it is not enforceable. It is therefore proposed to implement a prohibition of motor vehicles along that stretch of Bramshot Lane which is not designated as a bridleway.
