

## NOTICE OF MAKING AN ORDER

### HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

#### THE HAMPSHIRE (EAST HAMPSHIRE DISTRICT NO.39) (PARISH OF HEADLEY - PART OF FOOTPATH NO.20) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2026

---

The above-named Order, made on 28 May 2026 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert the public footpath from its current alignment commencing at SU 85191 37068 on Hammer Lane and proceeding through the driveway of the property known as Cobwebs to SU 85203 37078 at the property boundary, to a new alignment commencing at SU 85190 37072 on Hammer Lane and proceeding to SU 85203 37078, to the north-west of the current alignment.

Please state the grounds on which they are made.

The personal data you provide in any representation will be treated in accordance with Data Protection Legislation, and may be published in a decision report, be disclosed to other interested parties, including the landowner (or their representatives). It may also be made public if the matter is referred to the Planning Inspectorate. Your data will be retained for a maximum period of 3 years from the date that the application is resolved. The legal basis for our use of this information is the compliance with a legal obligation – Highways Act 1980.

This Order is made by Hampshire County Council (“the authority”) under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

This Order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (“the 1981 Act”) because it appears to the authority that the Hampshire Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way (dated 15<sup>th</sup> December 2007) require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

Ms Angelica Suarez has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new path into a fit condition for use by the public.

East Hants District Council have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

**BY THIS ORDER:**


1. The public right of way over the land situated at Headley shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up when Hampshire County Council has certified that the work necessary to bring the site of the new footpath, specified in paragraph 3 below, into a fit condition for use by the public has been carried out, and thereupon the Hampshire Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way (dated 15<sup>th</sup> December 2007) shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.
2. Notwithstanding this Order all Statutory Undertakers shall have the same rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 as they have hitherto enjoyed.
3. There shall be from the date of confirmation of this Order a public footpath over the land situate at Headley described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order, and thereupon the Hampshire Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way (dated 15<sup>th</sup> December 2007) shall be modified by adding that footpath to it.

3A. The Hampshire Definitive Statement of Public Rights of Way (dated 15<sup>th</sup> December 2007) shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this Order.

### PART 1

#### DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING RIGHTS OF WAY

##### **Headley Footpath No. 20 (A-B) SU 85203 37078 and SU 85191 37068**

That part of Footpath No. 20 in the Parish of Headley which commences at SU 85203 37078 (Point A on the Order Plan) and proceeds west-south-westwards to its junction with Hammer Lane, SU 85191 37068 (Point B).

Approximately 16 metres in length.

### PART 2

#### DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW RIGHT OF WAY

##### **Headley Footpath No. 20 (A-C) SU 85203 37078 and SU 85191 37072**

A 1.8 metre wide path in the Parish of Headley which commences at SU 85203 37078 (Point A on the Order Plan) and proceeds south-westwards then west-south-westwards to its junction with Hammer Lane, SU 85190 37072 (Point C).

Approximately 13 metres in length.

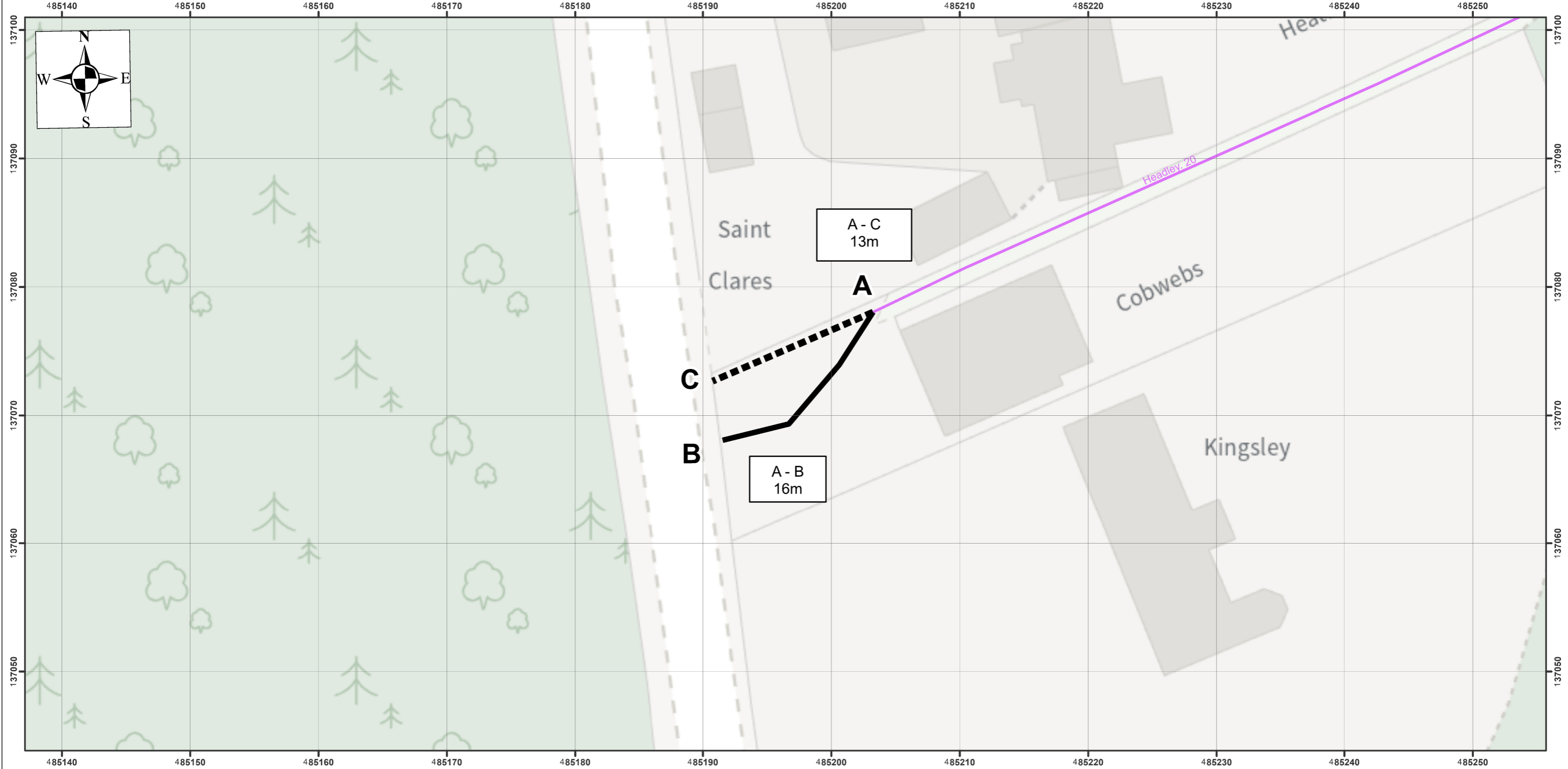
