

**THE HAMPSHIRE (BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE BOROUGH COUNCIL)
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PARKING
PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2021 (VARIATION NO. 15) ORDER 2026**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Hampshire County Council made the above-mentioned Order on Tuesday 23rd June 2026, in exercise of its powers and duties under 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“The Act”), Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, and having discharged its duty under section 122 of the Act.

GENERAL NATURE AND EFFECTS OF THE ORDER: Will be to implement a No Waiting at any Time restriction on Winklebury Way as described below:

- (i) on its south side, between its junction with Roman Road and a point 118 metres east of that point; and
- (ii) on its north side, between its junction with Roman Road and a point 70 metres east of that point.

DATE OF OPERATION: The order will come into force on Friday 10th July 2026.

1. In this Order:
“The Principal Order” means Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2021
2. Article 6 of The Principal Order shall have effect as though plans: AT41 and AT42 attached thereto are hereby suspended insofar as they relate to Winklebury Way and are replaced by plan: BG118 attached hereto.
3. The Principal Order shall be revoked to the extent specified in the Schedule to this Order

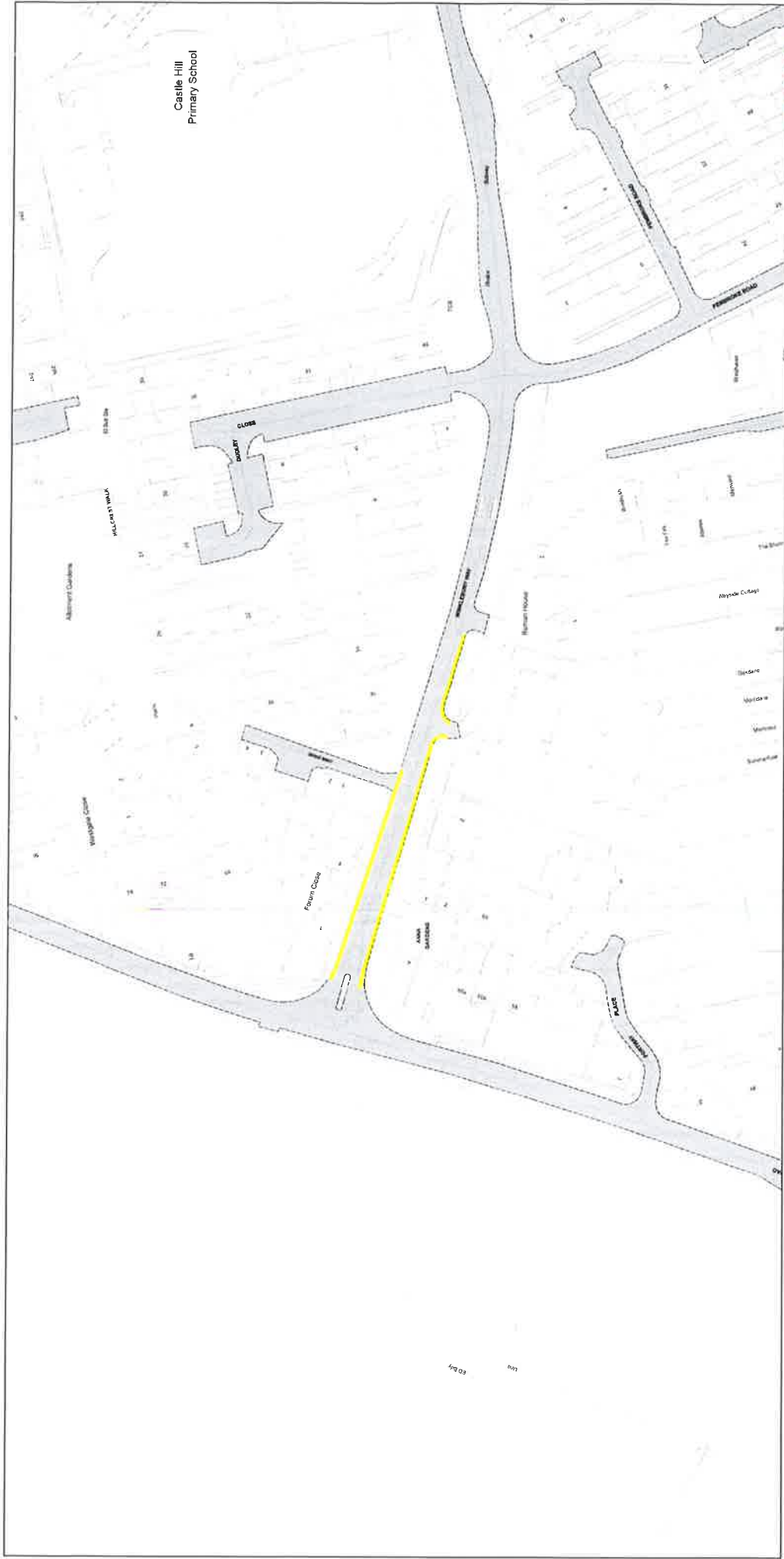

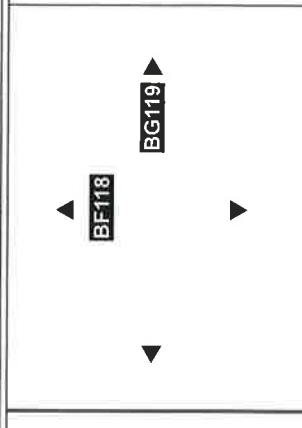

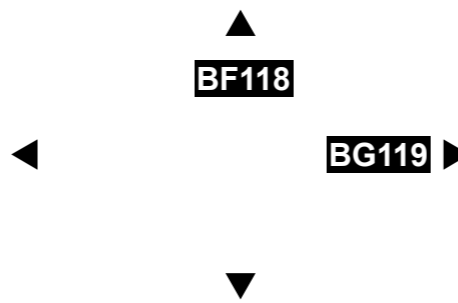

Statement of Reasons

A signalised junction is proposed at the junction between Winklebury Way and Roman Road. The proposed Traffic Regulation Order is designed to prevent vehicles parking in the vicinity of the traffic signals, ensuring their efficient operation.

The Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and Sections 63 and 64 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 (the Act of 1976) as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and in accordance with Section 63(2) of the Act of 1976, hereby makes the following Order.

SECTION 1 – PRELIMINARY

Citation and commencement

1. This Order shall come into operation on 7 August 2021 and may be cited as the Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2021.
2. The Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2021 Plans (the "Plans") are incorporated into this Order.

Interpretation

3. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them:

"Council" means Hampshire County Council or, as the case may be, Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council acting as Hampshire County Council's agents;

SECTION 6 - CONTRAVENTION OF ORDER

Contravention

- 87. If a vehicle is left in a prohibited or restricted road or parking place without complying with the requirements of this Order, a contravention shall have occurred and a penalty charge shall be payable.
- 88. Nothing in Articles 54 or 87 shall apply in respect of a vehicle displaying in a relevant position a valid disabled person's badge.
- 89. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

SECTION 7 - VALIDITY

- 90. If a court, the Department for Transport, the Traffic Penalty Tribunal or the Traffic Enforcement Centre declares any part of this Order to be invalid or unenforceable; such declaration shall not invalidate the remainder of the Order.

SECTION 8 - REVOCATIONS

- 91. The orders listed in Schedule 5 are hereby revoked.
