

NOTICE OF CONFIRMED ORDER

(PARISH OF UPTON GREY - PART OF FOOTPATH NO.14)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT
MODIFICATION ORDER 2026**

On the 01 July 2026 Hampshire County Council confirmed the above Order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the public footpath from its current alignment which commences at SU 6966 4844 at a junction with Upton Grey Footpath 8 and proceeds in a north-westerly direction for approximately 334 metres to SU 6935 4857; to a new alignment which commences at SU 6962 4839 at a junction with Upton Grey Footpaths 8 and 9 and proceeds in a westerly to north-westerly direction for approximately 359 metres to SU 6935 4857.

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the offices of Hampshire County Council, The Castle, Winchester, SO23 8UD, and at the offices of Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council, Civic Offices, London Road, Basingstoke, RG21 4AH at all reasonable hours; and online at www.hants.gov.uk/publicnotices. Copies of the Order and the map can be provided on request.

The Order comes into force when Hampshire County Council has certified that the work necessary to bring the new path into a fit condition for use by the public has been carried out, but if any person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 17 July 2026 make an application to the High Court.

This Order is made by Hampshire County Council ("the authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

This Order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the Hampshire Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way (dated 15th December 2007) require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

Mr John Frieda has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Upton Grey shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up when Hampshire County Council has certified that the work necessary to bring the site of the new footpath, specified in paragraph 3 below, into a fit condition for use by the public has been carried out, and thereupon the Hampshire Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way (dated 15th December 2007) shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.
2. Notwithstanding this Order all Statutory Undertakers shall have the same rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 as they have hitherto enjoyed.
3. There shall be from the date of confirmation of this Order a public footpath over the land situate at Upton Grey described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order, and thereupon the Hampshire Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way (dated 15th December 2007) shall be modified by adding that footpath to it.

3A. The Hampshire Definitive Statement of Public Rights of Way (dated 15th December 2007) shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this Order.

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING RIGHTS OF WAY

Upton Grey Footpath No. 14 (A-B)
SU 6966 4844 and SU 6935 4857

That part of Footpath No. 14 in the Parish of Upton Grey which commences at its junction with Footpath 8, SU 6966 4844 (Point A on the Order Plan) and proceeds north-westwards along a field edge to SU 6935 4857 (Point B).

Approximately 334 metres in length.

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW RIGHT OF WAY

Upton Grey Footpath No. 14 (C-B)
SU 6962 4839 and SU 6935 4857

A 3-metre-wide path in the Parish of Upton Grey which commences at its junction with Footpaths 8 and 9 SU 6962 4839 (Point C on the Order Plan) and proceeds westwards, then north-westwards, through a field to SU 6935 4857 (Point B).

Approximately 359 metres in length.

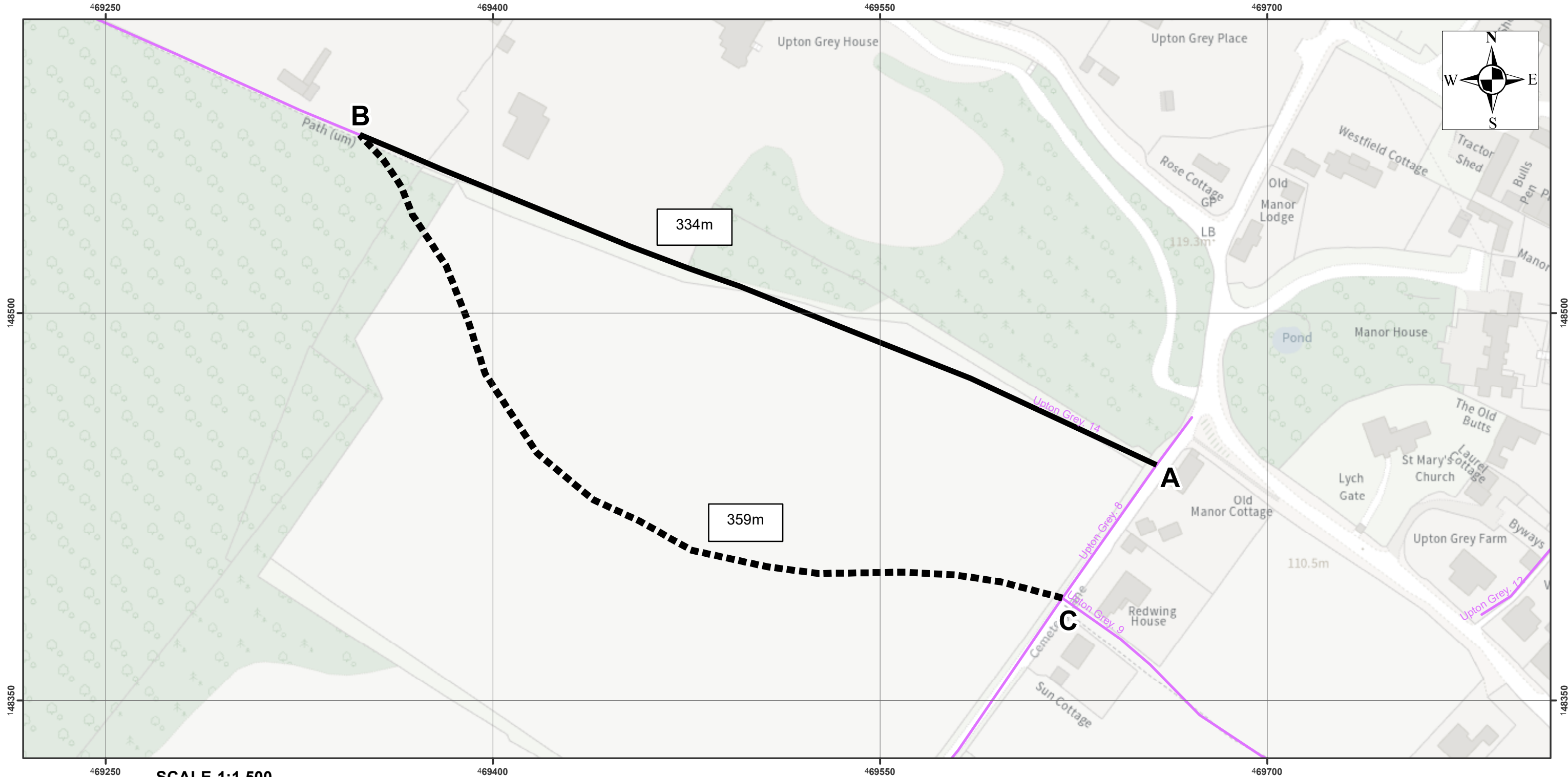
