

THE HAMPSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS, NEW ALRESFORD) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Hampshire County Council made the above-mentioned Order on Tuesday 21st July 2026, in exercise of its powers and duties under Sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 32, 35, 39, 122(1) and 122(2) of the Act, Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, and having discharged its duty under section 122 of the Act.

GENERAL NATURE AND EFFECTS OF THE ORDER: Will be to implement No Waiting at any Time restrictions; limited waiting Monday-Saturday, 9am – 6pm and Limited Waiting Mon-Sat 8am-6pm 2 hrs No return 2 hrs along the stretches of road in New Alresford as outlined in the schedules below:

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE HAMPSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS, NEW ALRESFORD) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2026

Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers and duties under Sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 32, 35, 39, 122(1) and 122(2) of the Act, Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following order:

1. In this order, and the preamble and schedules hereto:
“the Act” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
“enactment”, “local service”, “public service vehicle”, “taxi”, “taxi rank” and “telecommunications apparatus” have the same meaning as in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;
“pedal cycle” means a unicycle, bicycle, tricycle or cycle having four or more wheels, not being in any case mechanically propelled unless it is an electrically assisted pedal cycle that is not treated as a motor vehicle for the purposes of the 1984 Act, and
“road” means any length of highway or any other length of road to which the public has access and includes bridges over which a road passes.

PART II – AUTHORISATION AND USE OF PARKING PLACES

4. (i) Subject to the following provisions of this order, each of the parts of a road specified in schedule II to this order is authorised to be used as a parking place for such classes of vehicles, on such days, during such hours and for such maximum periods as are specified in the said schedule in relation to that part of the road.
(ii) Nothing in paragraph (i) of this article shall restrict the power of the Council to close any parking place.
5. Where in schedule II to this order a parking place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class, the driver of the vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that parking place:
 - (a) unless it is of the specified class; and
 - (b) unless it is positioned within the parking areas defined by white lines on the surface of the road and the distance between the edge of the carriageway and the nearest wheel of the vehicle is not more than fifty centimetres.
6. A driver of a vehicle shall not use a parking place:
 - (a) so as unreasonably to prevent access to any premises adjoining the road, or the use of the road by other persons, or so as to be a nuisance;
 - (b) when the Council has closed that parking place.
7. The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place and shall not start the engine except

when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.

8. No person shall use a vehicle, while it is in a parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services.
9. A vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge shall be exempt from any limitation on time specified in column 5 of part 1 of schedule II to this order.
10. Subject to the proviso hereto, when a vehicle is left in a parking place in contravention of any of the provisions contained in article 4, article 5 or article 6 of this order a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from that parking place; provided that when a vehicle is waiting in a parking place in contravention of the provision of article 5(b) of this order, a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with that provision.
11. Any person removing a vehicle or altering its position by virtue of the last preceding article of this order may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as he may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it or alter its position, as the case may be.
12. When a person authorised by the Council removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a vehicle from a parking place by virtue of article 10 of this order, he shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle.

PART III – PROHIBITION OF WAITING

13. Save as provided in articles 16 and 17 of this order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait:
 - (i) at any time on any side of road specified in schedule III to this order.
 - (ii) between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm from Monday to Saturday (both days inclusive) on any of the sides of road specified in Schedule VI to this Order
14. Save as provided in article 16 of this order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle, other than a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge or relevant parking permit to wait in the parking place as described in Schedule IV to this order.

15. Save as provided in article 16 of this order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to:
- (i) wait in the parking place as described in Schedule V to this order unless it displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge or relevant parking permit on the days Saturday to Thursday.
 - (ii) stop in the parking place as described in Schedule V unless it is a minibus on Fridays
16. Nothing in articles 13, 14 and 15 of this order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any side of road referred to in that article for so long as may be necessary:
- (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - (c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with the following operations namely:
 - (i) building or demolition;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said side of road;
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the said side of road, of any sewer, of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus;
 - (d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority, the Environment Agency or a water or sewerage undertaker within the meaning of the Water Act 1989 in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (e) to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said sides of road;
 - (f) to enable a public service vehicle being used in the operation of a local service to wait at any authorised stopping place for the purpose of:
 - (i) allowing a person to board or alight from the vehicle or to pay a fare, or
 - (ii) allowing the vehicle to wait, if it arrives at the stopping place in advance of the advertised time for a period not exceeding 2 minutes;
 - (g) to enable the vehicle to be used in the service of a licensed universal postal service provider for the purpose of sorting, delivering or collecting postal packets in the course of the provision of a universal postal service as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000;
 - (h) to enable the vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the said side of road for so long as is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral;
 - (i) to enable the vehicle to be used for fire and rescue service, ambulance or police purposes; or
 - (j) to enable the vehicle to be used by a registered medical practitioner, midwife or district nurse in the course of his or her professional duties.
16. Nothing in article 13 of this order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and, if appropriate, a

parking disc (on which the driver or other person in charge of the vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on any side of road referred to in that article for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same road on the same day) unless it is a road listed in Schedule IV and Schedule V (on the relevant days) to this order in which case there is no limit applied.

17. In the event of any dispute as to the meaning of any heading or legend used in any part of this order, any schedule to this order or any plan attached to this order, the substantive wording in the order or schedule shall prevail over the heading or legend. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
18. Each of the orders listed in Schedule I to this order are hereby revoked.
19. This order shall come into force on *Monday 17th August* 2026 and may be cited as "The Hampshire (Various Roads, New Alresford) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Parking Places) Order 2026".

Statement of Reasons

Spring Gardens/ New Farm Road

Members of the public have raised concerns about vehicles parking on the bend / junction of Spring Gardens with New Barn Road forcing drivers onto the wrong side to the road at a blind bend. Therefore, we are proposing a 'no waiting at any time' restriction (double yellow lines) at the junction and bend. The proposal is supported by Hampshire's Passenger Transport team. If implemented this will aid vehicles movements at the junction/ bend.

In addition, there have also been reports from Freightways, that the articulated lorries delivering and collecting from their premises are obstructed by vehicles parking opposite their access. Therefore a 'no waiting Monday – Saturday 9am to 6pm' restriction is proposed. If implemented this will allow clear access for large vehicles to this business.

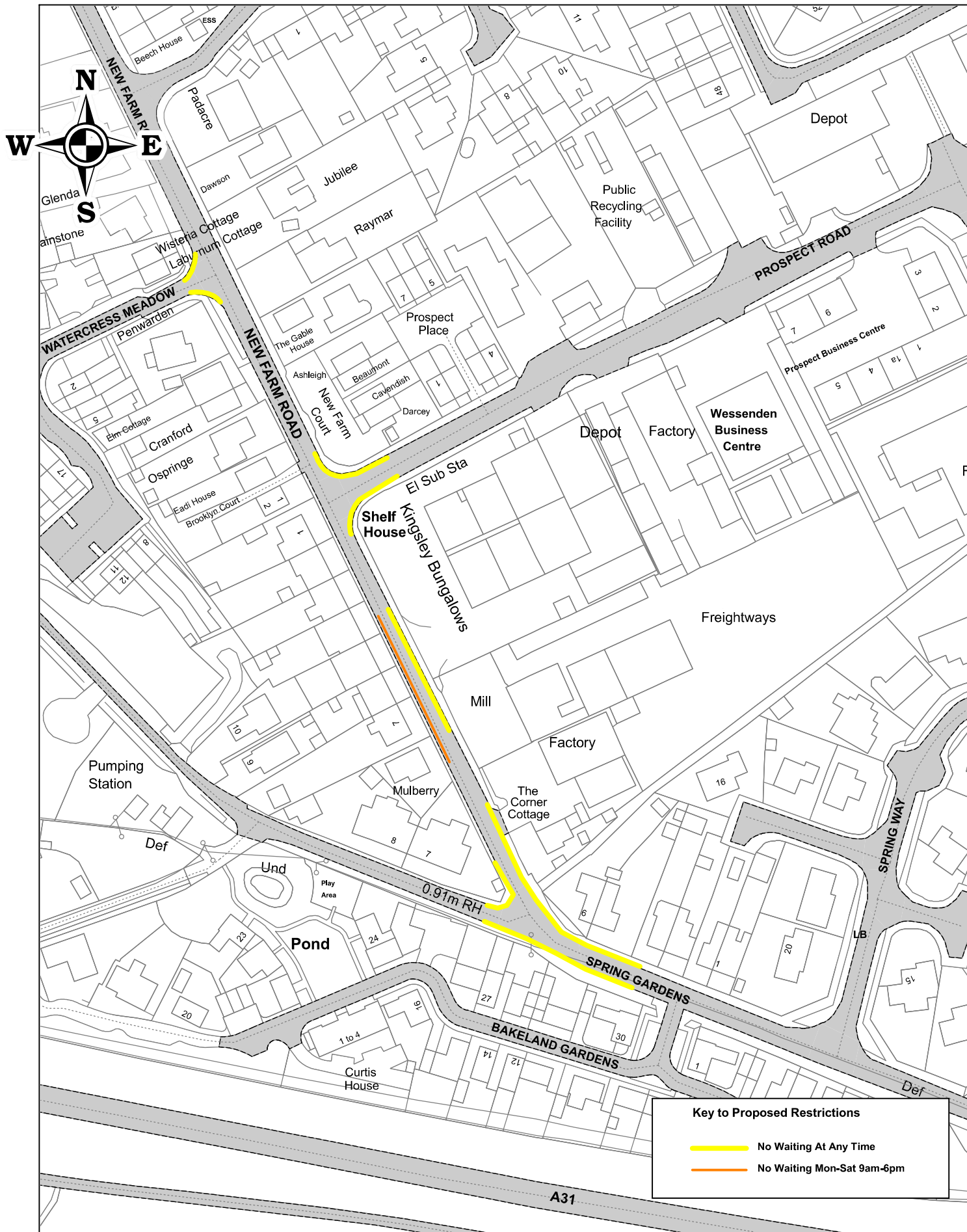
Prospect Road / Watercress Meadow

The existing white lining at the junctions of New Farm Road and Prospect Road, and New Farm Road and Watercress Meadow, are proposed to be formalised as double yellow lines.

The Dean

The previously industrial site of 1-3 The Dean has planning permission (ref 23/00701/FUL) for demolition of existing buildings and construction of 14 apartments and a 40 space public car park.

To ensure suitable visibility splays for the new vehicle access, it is proposed to remove five Limited Waiting Mon-Sat 8am-6pm 2 hrs No return 2 hrs parking bays, and replace them with double yellow lines. This has been identified in the s278 agreement and safety audit recommendations.
