DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2026**

The above named Order made on 16 July 2026, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by recording four footpaths in the parishes of South Wonston and Kings Worthy, as follows:

- SU 4621 3563 to SU 4627 3547 – South Wonston Footpath 503 - commencing at a junction with South Wonston Restricted Byway 703 and proceeding southwards to a junction with Footpath 506;
- SU 4652 3564 to SU 4649 3552 – South Wonston Footpath 504 - commencing at a junction with South Wonston Restricted Byway 703 and proceeding south-south-westwards to a junction with Footpath 506;
- SU 4676 3564 to SU 4677 3549 – South Wonston Footpath 505 – commencing at a junction with South Wonston Restricted Byway 703 and proceeding generally southwards to a junction with Footpath 506;
- SU 4625 3552 to SU 4698 3547 – South Wonston Footpath 506/Kings Worthy Footpath 518 – commencing at a junction with Footpath 503 and proceeding generally eastwards to a junction with Kings Worthy Bridleway 517. A spur runs between SU 4631 3552 to SU 4627 3547, also connecting this path to Footpath 503.

Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Head of Countryside Access, Universal Services, Hampshire County Council, Castle Avenue, Winchester, SO23 8UD, or via the internet to row.notices@hants.gov.uk quoting reference: - DMMO 245 no later than 18 September 2026. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

The personal data you provide in any representation will be treated in accordance with Data Protection Legislation. We will only use the information you provide in connection with the determination of this Order. It may be made public if the matter is referred to the Planning Inspectorate. It will become part of the permanent records kept on rights

of way in Hampshire. The legal basis for our use of this information is the compliance with a legal obligation – Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

If no such representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, Hampshire County Council may, instead of submitting the Order or part of it to the Secretary of State, if the authority has by Notice to the Secretary of State so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, itself confirm the Order or part of the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs in whole or in part, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.

This Order is made by Hampshire County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs has directed under paragraph 4(2) of Schedule 14 of the Act that The Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way and The Definitive Statement of Public Rights of Way (Dated 15th December 2007) requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3) of the Act namely:-

c) the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows

- (i) that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path;

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates.

Hampshire County Council hereby orders that:

1. For the purposes of the Order the relevant date is 1 June 2026.
2. The Hampshire Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way and The Hampshire Definitive Statement of Public Rights of Way (Dated 15th December 2007) shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule as shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The Hampshire (City of Winchester No.60) (Parish of South Wonston and Parish of Kings Worthy) Definitive Map Modification Order 2026.

PART I

Modifications of Definitive Map Description of path or way to be added

South Wonston Footpath 503

From grid reference SU 4621 3563 to SU 4627 3547

A new footpath, commencing at a junction with South Wonston Restricted Byway 703 (point A on the Order map) and proceeding in a south-south-easterly direction to a junction with South Wonston Footpath 506, (point B on the Order map) and then continuing to a further junction with South Wonston Footpath 506 (point C on the Order map).

1.5 metres wide between points A and point B on the Order map.

Varying between 6 and 7.5 metres wide between points B and C on the Order map, as shown by grey shading on the Order map.

A total length of 171 metres.

South Wonston Footpath 504

From grid reference SU 4652 3564 to SU 4649 3552

A new footpath, commencing at a junction with South Wonston Restricted Byway 703 (point E on the Order map) and proceeding in a south-south-westerly direction to a junction with South Wonston Footpath 506 (point F on the Order map).

Varying between 3 and 7 metres in width, as shown by grey shading on the Order map.

A total length of 116 metres.

South Wonston Footpath 505

From grid reference SU 4676 3564 to SU 4677 3549

A new footpath, commencing at a junction with South Wonston Restricted Byway 703 (point G on the Order map) and proceeding in a south-south-easterly direction, then a southerly and then south-westerly direction to a junction with South Wonston Footpath 506 (point H on the Order map).

1.5 metres wide between point G and point X on the Order map.

Varying between 3.5 and 8.5 metres wide between points X and H, as shown by grey shading on the Order map.

A total length of 164 metres.

South Wonston Footpath 506

From grid reference SU 4625 3552 to SU 4698 3547 and a spur from SU 4631 3552 to SU 4627 3547

A new footpath, commencing at a junction with South Wonston Footpath 503 (point B on the Order map) and proceeding in a generally easterly direction through a junction with South Wonston Footpath 504 (point F on the Order map) and South Wonston Footpath 505 (point H on the Order map) and then on to the parish boundary (point Y on the Order map) and a junction with Kings Worthy Footpath 518.

Spur: From a point approximately 68 metres from the commencement of the footpath (point D on the Order map) proceeding in a south-westerly direction to a junction with South Wonston Footpath 503 (point C on the Order map).

Varying between 5.5 and 13.5 metres in width, as shown by grey shading on the Order map.

A length of 734 metres and a spur length of 60 metres.

Kings Worthy Footpath 518

From grid reference SU 4698 3547 to SU 4704 3546

A new footpath, commencing at the parish boundary and a junction with South Wonston Footpath 506 (point Y on the Order map) and proceeding in a generally easterly direction to a junction with Kings Worthy Bridleway 517 (point I on the Order map).

Varying between 4.5 and 6 metres in width, as shown by grey shading on the Order map.

A total length of 55 metres.

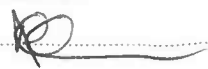

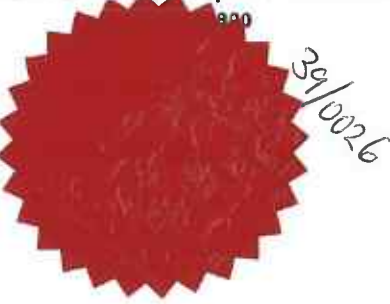
