ORDER 2026**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Hampshire County Council made the above-mentioned Order on Tuesday 4th August 2026, in exercise of its powers and duties under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, and having discharged its duty under section 122 of the Act.

GENERAL NATURE AND EFFECTS OF THE ORDER: Will be to replace a section of the existing No Waiting Monday – Saturday from 8am to 7pm restrictions with No Waiting at any Time restrictions along Stephenson Road in Basingstoke as outlined in the below schedule:

REVOCATIONS

No Waiting Monday – Saturday 8am – 7pm

Stephenson Road, North, between a point 15.5 metres west of its junction with Houndmills Road and a point 58 metres west thereof.

Stephenson Road, South, between a point 15.5 metres west of its junction with Houndmills Road and a point 57 metres west thereof.

IMPLEMENTATIONS

No Waiting at any Time

Stephenson Road, North, between a point 15.5 metres west of its junction with Houndmills Road and a point 58 metres west thereof.

Statement of reasons

The current "No Waiting" restrictions on Stephenson Road are frequently being ignored, particularly by HGV drivers, with vehicles and trailers often left parked on the north side at the eastern end of the road. The local Gymnastics Club has expressed concerns that such parking causes congestion during peak times, with queues extending onto Houndmills Road.

To address this issue, it is proposed to amend the existing order by upgrading the restrictions to "No Waiting At Any Time." This change aims to eliminate any ambiguity about when the restrictions apply and to ensure the smooth flow of traffic on both Stephenson Road and Houndmills Road. The proposal includes applying the restriction to both sides of Stephenson Road equally, to prevent the problem from simply shifting to the southern side and continuing to impact the wider road network.

3. The Principal Order shall be revoked to the extent specified in the Schedule to this Order
4. This Order shall come into operation on the *Saturday 22nd August* 2026 and may be cited as “The Hampshire (Basingstoke and Deane) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2026 (Variation No. 3) (Stephenson Road) Order 2026”.

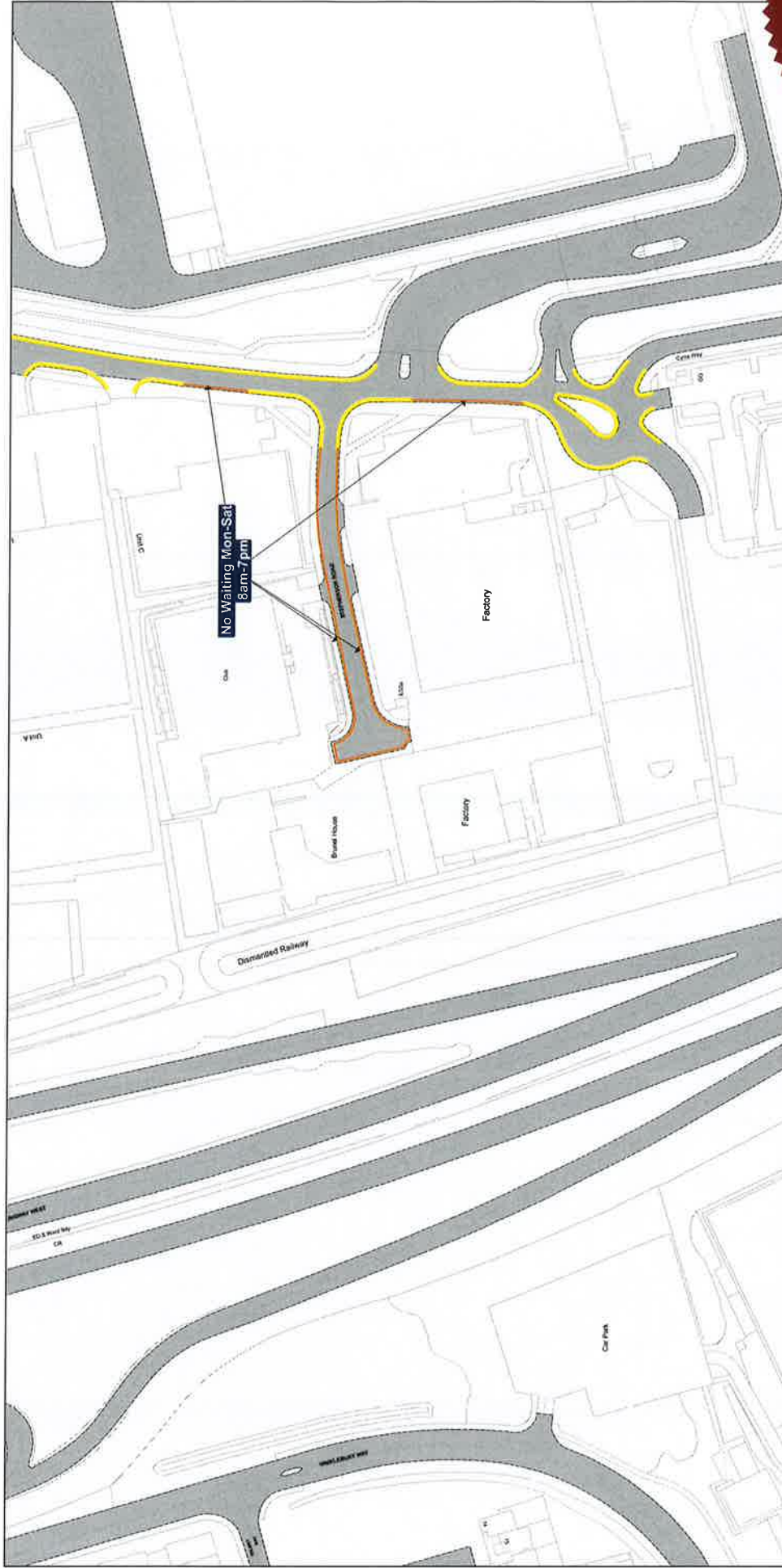
