

**THE HAMPSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS, BENTLEY AND FRITH END)
(30 AND 40 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2026**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Hampshire County Council made the above-mentioned Order on Tuesday 4th August 2026, in exercise of its powers and duties under Sections 84 and 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, and having discharged its duty under section 122 of the Act.

GENERAL NATURE AND EFFECTS OF THE ORDER: Will be to implement a 30 mile per hour speed limit (currently 40 miles per hour) on C98 Frith End Road between a point 30 metres north-west of its junction with A325 Farnham Road and a point 40 metres north of the private access entrance point to the properties known as Wychwood, Highview and Meadow View, an approximate distance of 1,070 metres.

DATE OF OPERATION: The order will come into force on Saturday 15th August 2026.

Hampshire County Council in exercise of its powers and duties under Sections 84 and 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following order:

1. In this order, and the preamble and schedule hereto:

“the Act” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

“mph” means miles per hour;

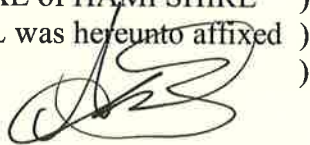
“road” means any length of highway or any other length of road to which the public has access, and includes bridges over which a road passes; and

“special forces” has the same meaning as defined in The Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011

2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 mph on any of those roads specified in Schedule I to this order.
3. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 mph on any of those roads specified in Schedule II to this order.
4. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
5. The Hampshire (Various Roads, Bentley and Frith End) (30 and 40 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2013 is hereby revoked.
6. This order shall come into force on *Saturday 15th August* 2026 and may be cited as “Hampshire (Various Roads, Bentley and Frith End) (30 and 40 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2026”.

SCHEDULE I

Roads at Bentley in the District of East Hampshire 30 mph Speed Limit

- (i) C70 (old A31) between a point 154 metres west of its junction with Station Road and a point 123 metres east of its junction with School Road, an approximate distance of 732 metres.
- (ii) C98 Station Road between its junction with C70 (old A31) and a point 134 metres south thereof.
- (iii) C98 Hole Lane (north) between its junction with the C70 (old A31) and a point 130 metres north of its junction with Church Lane, an approximate distance of 730 metres.
- (iv) C98 Hole Lane (east) between its junction with C98 Hole Lane (north) and a point 141 metres east of its junction with School Lane, an approximate distance of 563 metres.
- (v) C98 Frith End Road / Blacknest Road between a point 30 metres north-west of its junction with A325 Farnham Road and a point 40 metres north of the private access entrance point to the properties known as Wychwood, Highview and Meadow View, an approximate distance of 1,070 metres.

- (vi) Church Lane

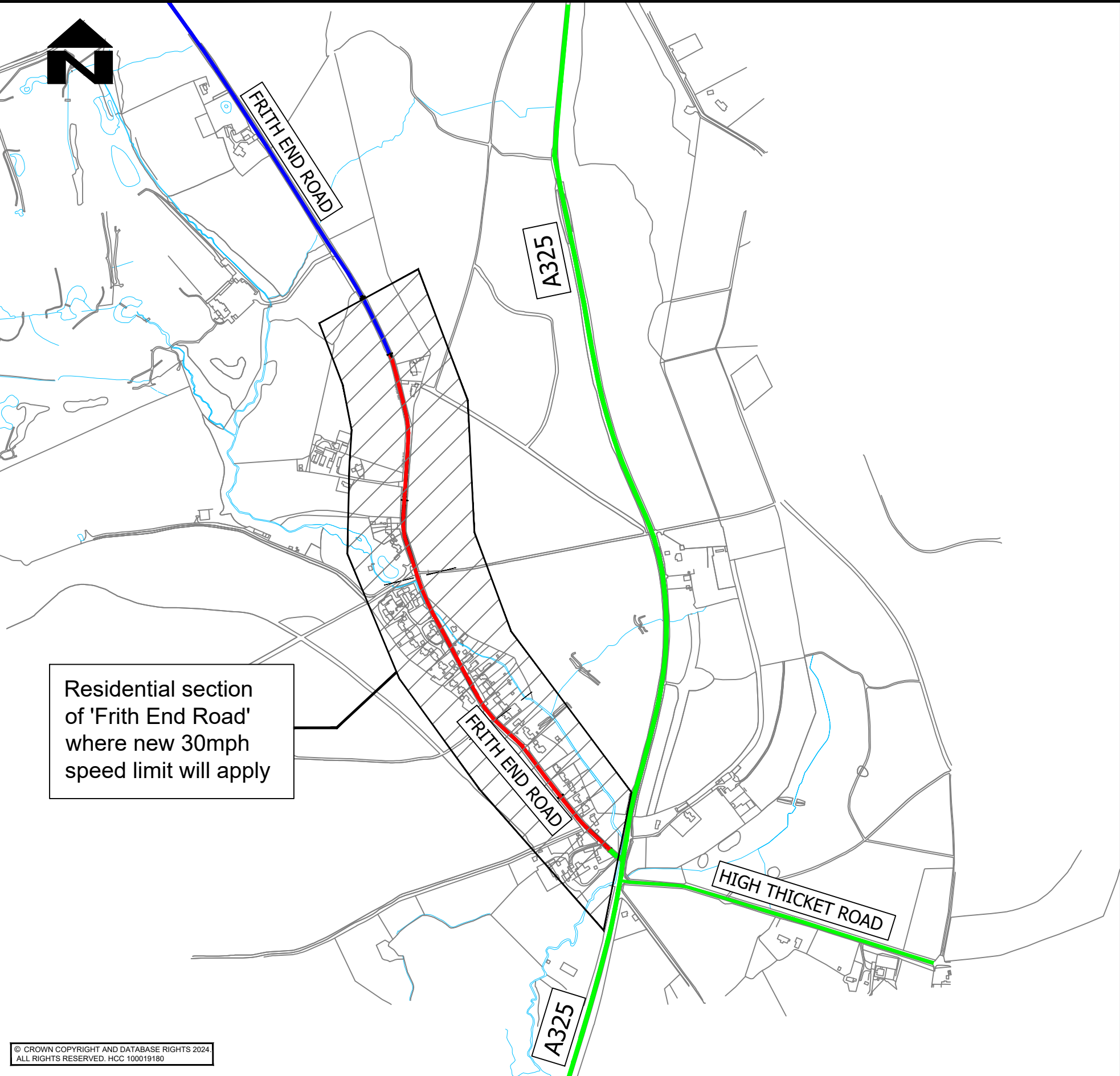
Roads at Bentley in the District of East Hampshire 40 mph Speed Limit

- (i) C98 Station Road / Blacknest Road / Frith End Road between a point 134 metres south of its junction with C70 (old A31) and a point 40 metres north of the private access entrance point to the properties known as Wychwood, Highview and Meadow View, an approximate distance of 3,155 metres.
- (ii) C70 (old A31) between its junction with Isington Lane and a point 154 metres west of its junction with Station Road, an approximate distance of 853 metres.
- (iii) C70 (old A31) between a point 123 metres east of its junction with School Lane and a point 263 metres east of that point.
- (iv) C70 (old A31) between its junction with C70 Isington Lane and a point 110 metres south-west thereof.

- (v) C70 Isington Lane between its junction with C70 (old A31) and a point 290 metres south-east then south-west thereof.
- (vi) C203 Isington Road between its junction with C98 Blacknest Road and a point 222 metres west thereof.
- (vii) C84 Binsted Road between its junction with C98 Blacknest Road and a point 264 metres west thereof.

Statement of Reasons

As part of the ongoing development work in and around Bordon and Whitehill, Hampshire County Council are carrying out a Statutory Consultation for a new 30mph speed limit in Frith End Road.

A 30mph speed limit will help reduce traffic speeds for the busy residential section of Frith End Road helping safety at junctions and private access points.

1. In this order, and the preamble and schedule hereto :

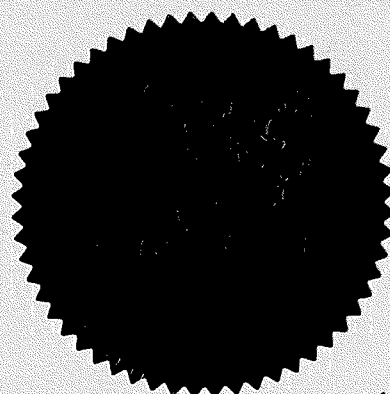

“special forces” has the same meaning as defined in The Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011
2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 mph on any of those roads specified in schedule I to this order.
3. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 mph on any of those roads specified in schedule II to this order.
4. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
5. The following orders are hereby revoked:
 - (i) The Hampshire (A31 Bentley) (40 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 1989;
 - (ii) The Hampshire (C98 Frith End Road, Frith End) (40 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2001; and
 - (iii) The Hampshire (Various Roads, Bentley) (Restricted Road and 40 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2007.
6. This order shall come into operation on 21 January 2013 and may be cited as “The Hampshire (Various Roads, Bentley and Frith End) (30 and 40 Miles per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2013.”

SCHEDULE I

Roads at Bentley in the District of East Hampshire 30 mph Speed Limit

- (i) C70 (old A31) between a point 154 metres west of its junction with Station Road and a point 123 metres east of its junction with School Lane, an approximate distance of 732 metres.
- (ii) C98 Station Road between its junction with C70 (old A31) and a point 134 metres south thereof.
- (iii) C98 Hole Lane (north) between its junction with the C70 (old A31) and a point 130 metres north of its junction with Church Lane, an approximate distance of 730 metres.
- (iv) C98 Hole Lane (east) between its junction with C98 Hole Lane (north) and a point 141 metres east of its junction with School Lane, an approximate distance of 563 metres.
- (v) Church Lane, for its entire length, an approximate distance of 379 metres.
- (vi) School Lane, for its entire length, an approximate distance of 465 metres.
- (vii) Oakway, for its entire length, an approximate distance of 39 metres.

SCHEDULE II

Roads at Bentley and Frith End in the District of East Hampshire 40 mph Speed Limit

- (i) C98 Station Road / Blacknest Road / Frith End Road between a point 134 metres south of its junction with C70 (old A31) and its junction with A325 Farnham Road, an approximate distance of 4225 metres.
- (ii) C70 (old A31) between its junction with Isington Lane and a point 154 metres west of its junction with Station Road, an approximate distance of 853 metres.
- (iii) C70 (old A31) between a point 123 metres east of its junction with School Lane and a point 263 metres east of that point.
- (iv) C70 (old A31) between its junction with C70 Isington Lane and a point 110 metres south-west thereof.
- (v) C70 Isington Lane between its junction with C70 (old A31) and a point 290 metres south-east then south-west thereof.
- (vi) C203 Isington Road between its junction with C98 Blacknest Road and a point 222 metres west thereof.
- (vii) C203 Station Road, for its entire length, an approximate distance of 515 metres.

- (viii) Weybank, for its entire length, an approximate distance of 115 metres.
 - (ix) C84 Binsted Road between its junction with C98 Blacknest Road and a point 264 metres west thereof.
 - (x) C84 Bucks Horn Oak between its junction with C98 Blacknest Road and a point 100 metres east thereof.
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
