On 30 July 2026 Hampshire County Council confirmed the above Order made under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to extinguish that part of the above-named public footpath which commences at SU 6434 5194 and proceeds eastwards to a junction with Footpath 10 at SU 6462 5199.

The Order came into force on 30 July 2026, but if any person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 21 August 2026 make an application to the High Court.

This Order is made by Hampshire County Council ("the authority") under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that the footpath described in paragraph 1 below is not needed for public use.

This order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the Hampshire Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way (dated 15th December 2007) require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the stopping up (as authorised by this order) of a highway hitherto shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council has been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated in the Parish of Basingstoke and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be extinguished upon the confirmation of this Order, and thereupon the Hampshire Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way (dated 15th December 2007) shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way, and the definitive statement shall be modified as described in the Schedule to this order.
2. Notwithstanding this Order all Statutory Undertakers shall have the same rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 as they have hitherto enjoyed.

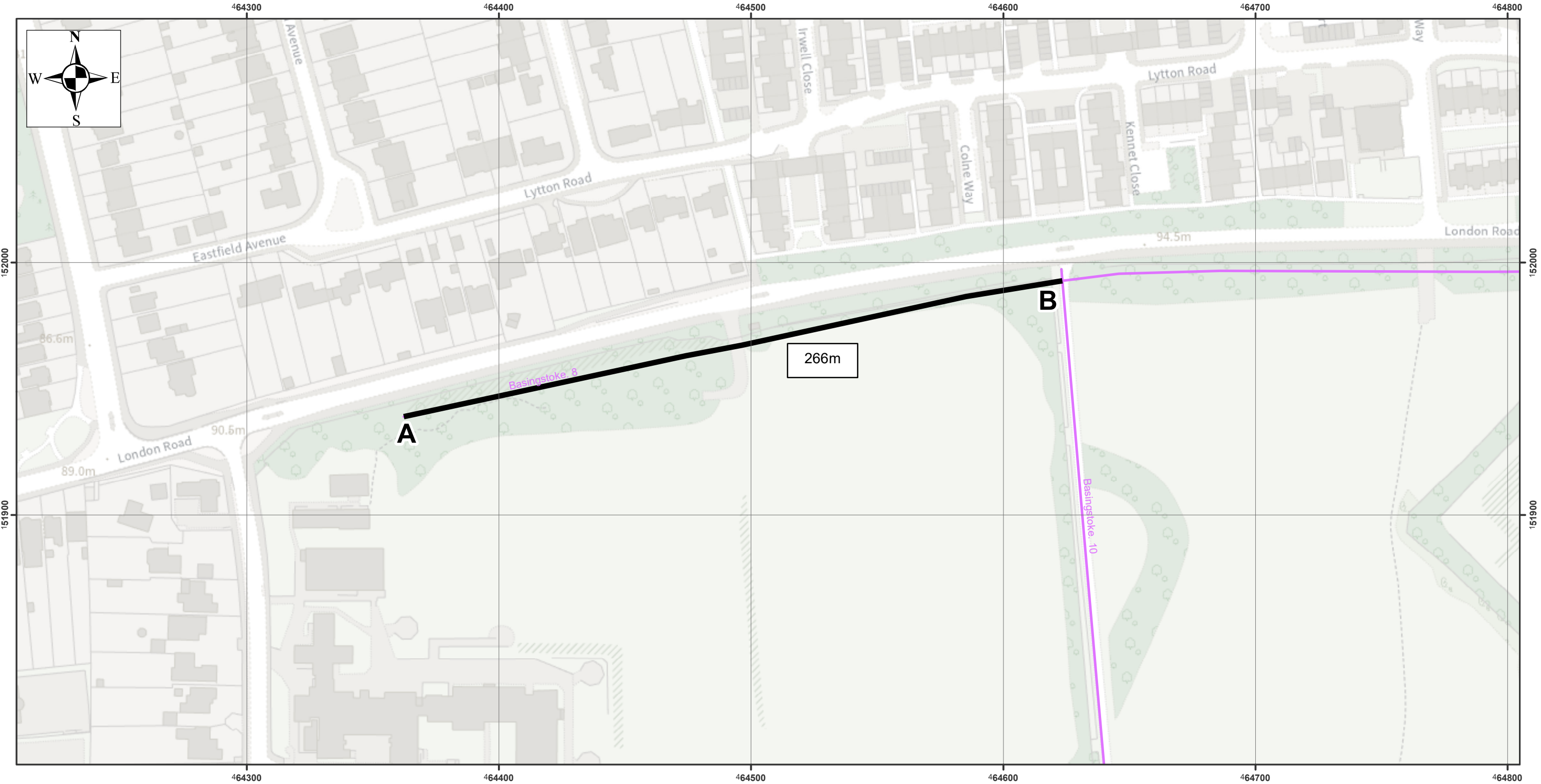
