THE HAMPSHIRE (TEST VALLEY BOROUGH NO.75) (PARISH OF BARTON STACEY) DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2026

The above named Order made on 20 August 2026, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by recording a restricted byway commencing at a junction with Barton Stacey Bridleway 12 and proceeding in a south-easterly direction to connect with Barton Stacey Restricted Byway 8.

Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Head of Countryside Access, Universal Services, Hampshire County Council, Castle Avenue, Winchester, SO23 8UD, or via the internet to row.notices@hants.gov.uk quoting reference:- DMMO 1236 no later than 23 October 2026. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

The personal data you provide in any representation will be treated in accordance with Data Protection Legislation. We will only use the information you provide in connection with the determination of this Order. It may be made public if the matter is referred to the Planning Inspectorate. It will become part of the permanent records kept on rights of way in Hampshire. The legal basis for our use of this information is the compliance with a legal obligation – Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs in whole or in part, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.

This Order is made by Hampshire County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that The Definitive Map Of Public Rights of Way and The Definitive Statement of Public Rights of Way (Dated 15th December 2007) requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3) c) (i) of the Act namely:-

c) the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows

- (i) that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a restricted byway;

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates.

Hampshire County Council hereby orders that:

1. For the purposes of the Order the relevant date is 10 August 2026.
2. The Hampshire Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way and The Hampshire Definitive Statement of Public Rights of Way (Dated 15th December 2007) shall be modified as described in Part I [and Part II] of the Schedule as shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The Hampshire (Test Valley Borough No.75) (Parish of Barton Stacey) Definitive Map Modification Order 2026.

A new restricted byway, commencing at a junction with Barton Stacey Bridleway 12 (Point A on the Order map) and proceeding in a south-easterly direction to a junction with Newton Stacey Lane (public road T54) and Barton Stacey Restricted Byway 8 (Point B).

Varying between 9 and 14 metres wide, as shown by grey shading on the Order map.
