

NOTICE OF MAKING AN ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

HAMPSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

THE HAMPSHIRE (BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE NO.38) (PARISH OF PAMBER - PART OF FOOTPATH NO.35) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2026

The above-named Order, made on 20 August 2026 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert the public footpath from its current alignment commencing at a point on Frog Lane and proceeding in a north-westerly direction to the field boundary to a new alignment commencing at that point on Frog Lane and proceeding in a westerly direction, parallel to the road to a tree line, continuing northwards along a field boundary to rejoin the path.

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the offices of Hampshire County Council, The Castle, Winchester, SO23 8UD and at the offices of Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council, Civic Offices, London Road, Basingstoke, RG21 4AH; or online at www.hants.gov.uk/publicnotices. Copies of the Order and the map can be provided on request.

Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Head of Countryside Access, Universal Services, Hampshire County Council, The Castle, Winchester, SO23 8UD or via e-mail to row.notices@hants.gov.uk quoting reference:- PPO 5276 no later than 16 October 2026. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

The personal data you provide in any representation will be treated in accordance with Data Protection Legislation, and may be published in a decision report, be disclosed to other interested parties, including the landowner (or their representatives). It may also be made public if the matter is referred to the Planning Inspectorate. Your data will be retained for a maximum period of 3 years from the date that the application is resolved. The legal basis for our use of this information is the compliance with a legal obligation – Highways Act 1980.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, Hampshire County Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed order. MODIFICATION ORDER 2026**

This Order is made by Hampshire County Council ("the authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

This Order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the Hampshire Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way (dated 15th December 2007) require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Pamber shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up when Hampshire County Council has confirmed the order and thereupon the Hampshire Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way (dated 15th December 2007) shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.
2. Notwithstanding this Order all Statutory Undertakers shall have the same rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 as they have hitherto enjoyed.
3. There shall be from the date of confirmation of this Order a public footpath over the land situate at Pamber described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order, and thereupon the Hampshire Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way (dated 15th December 2007) shall be modified by adding that footpath to it.
- 3A. The Hampshire Definitive Statement of Public Rights of Way (dated 15th December 2007) shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this Order.

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING RIGHTS OF WAY

Pamber Footpath No 35 From SU 6321 6005 to SU 6311 6016

That part of Pamber Footpath No.35 which commences at a junction with Frog Lane, SU 6321 6005 (Point A on the Order Plan) and proceeding north-westwards to SU 6311 6016 (Point C).

Approximately 162 metres in length.

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW RIGHT OF WAY

Pamber Footpath No 35 From SU 6321 6005 to SU 6311 6016 via SU 6313 6007

A 1.5-metre-wide path in the Parish of Pamber, commencing at a junction with Frog Lane, SU 6321 6005 (Point A on the order plan) proceeding westwards to SU 6313 6007 (Point B) proceeding northwards to SU 6311 6016 (Point C).

Approximately 177 metres in length.

MODIFICATION OF DEFINITIVE STATEMENT

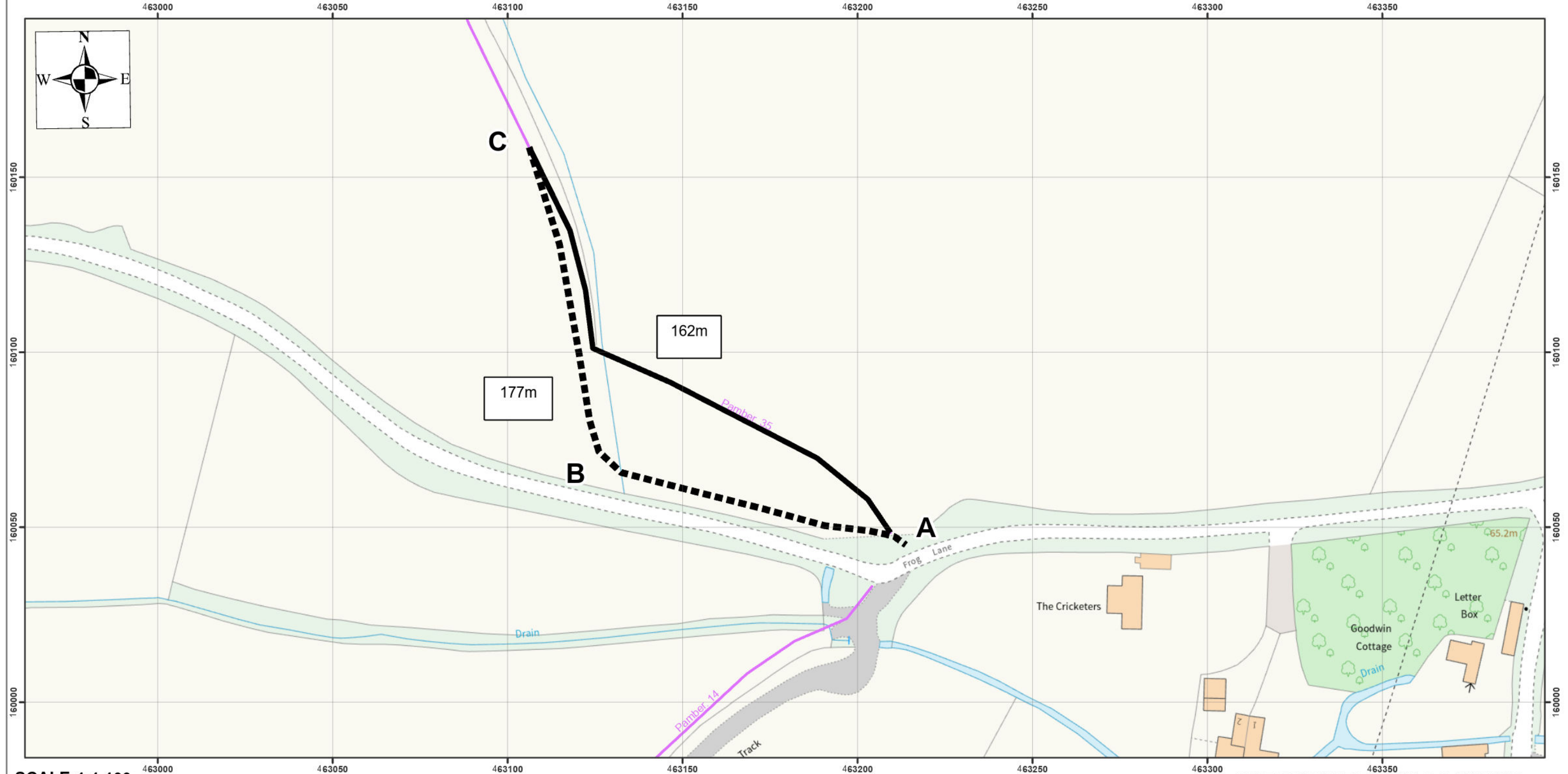
Variation of particulars of path or way
