HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

THE HAMPSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (B3334 STUBBINGTON BYPASS
CLASSIFIED ROAD) (SIDE ROADS) ORDER 2018

THE SECRETARY OF STATE for Transport hereby gives notice that on 20 May 2019, he has confirmed, with modifications, the above Order which was made by Hampshire County Council under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 and which, as confirmed, authorises the Council to –

- a) improve highways;
- b) stop up highways;
- c) stop up private means of access to premises; and
- d) provide new means of access to premises,

all in the vicinity of the route of the classified road known as B3334 Stubbington Bypass (Classified Road) which the Council are proposing to construct/improve between a point adjacent to 'Westlea', 302, Titchfield Road to a point 220m east of the junction of Gosport Road and Marks Road.

COPIES of the above mentioned Order and associated plans may be inspected during normal opening hours at Hampshire County Council, The Castle, Winchester SO23 8UJ, Stubbington Library, Stubbington Lane, Stubbington, Fareham PO14 2PP and Fareham Library, 7 Thackeray Mall, Osborn Road, Fareham PO16 7EN.

ANY PERSON aggrieved by or desiring to question the validity of any provision within the Order on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement or regulation made has not been complied with, may, within 6 weeks of 6 June 2019, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision included.
