- A judging panel will select a winner by Thursday 1 September 2022.
- Submitted designs must be original artwork created by year 4 Hampshire school pupils between 25 April and 22 July 2022. Employees of Hampshire Countryside Service, their families, agencies or anyone else connected with this competition are not eligible to enter.
- The Promoter reserves the right to discount or disqualify any inappropriate entries.
- The competition is free to enter and there is no purchase necessary.
- The winner's prize is an activity day at Runway's End Outdoor Centre for 1 (one) class (up to 32 pupils) to include 3 activities from 9.30am to 3pm, which may include abseiling, archery, kayaking, canoeing, high ropes and raft building. Dates and activities are subject to availability.
- The prize is non-negotiable, non-refundable, non-transferable, and non-exchangeable and no cash alternative offered.
- The prize must be used within the 2022/23 academic year: from 1 September 2022 to 21 July 2023.
