

Hampshire Countryside Service Urban Photography Competition Terms and Conditions

1. The Promoter of this urban nature photography competition is the Hampshire Countryside Service (the “Promoter”).
2. The competition will start on Friday 8 January 2021 and close on Sunday 31 January 2021.
3. Entries received after 11.59pm on Sunday 31 January 2021 will not be counted.
4. Entrants must:
 - (a) not be professional photographers,
 - (b) not be staff or relations of staff at the Hampshire Countryside Service, and
5. For an entry to be valid, the photographs must:
 - (a) be taken in Hampshire,
 - (b) be the total and exclusive work of the submitting photographer,
 - (c) not include images of people (including people’s faces), the use of clip art, or elements of stock photography,
6. To enter, entrants need to upload an original photograph (maximum three entries per person) to Instagram or Twitter using #doorstepnature and tagging @HampshireCountryside (Instagram) or @HantsCS (Twitter).
7. Incomplete or late entries will not be accepted. The Promoter reserves the right to discount or disqualify any inappropriate or offensive entries.
8. The competition is free to enter.
9. There will be one winner for each category, adult and under-16s. Each category will also have two runners-up whose photos will be shared on The Promoter’s social platforms.
10. Prizes are non-negotiable, non-refundable, non-transferable and non-exchangeable and no cash alternative offered.
11. The Promoter reserves the right to provide a substitute prize of equal or greater value should the prize granted become unavailable for reasons beyond its control.
12. Finalists will be chosen by countryside rangers before the winner is selected by the head of the service. The winners will be selected by Sunday 14 February 2021 and will be notified the same day or as soon as practicable after this date via social media. The judges’ decisions will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
13. The Promoter must publish or make available information that indicates that a valid award took place. To comply with this obligation, the Promoter will publish the first name and town (or location of photo) of the major prize winners and runners-up and, if applicable, their winning entries on the Hampshire Countryside Service social media pages.
14. If you object to your name or town being published or made available, please contact the Promoter at marketing@hants.gov.uk. The Promoter must still provide the information to the Advertising Standards Authority on request.
15. The Promoter will make all reasonable efforts to contact the winners. If a winner cannot be contacted or is not available, or has not claimed their prize within 28 of days of being notified, the Promoter reserves the right to offer the prize to the next eligible entrant.
16. Entrants will retain copyright in the photographs that they submit as entries (“competition entries”). By entering the competition, all entrants agree to grant to the Hampshire Countryside Service a non-exclusive, irrevocable licence of any intellectual property rights in the competition entries to use, publish and exhibit the competition entries via its media (for example, the website or social media) and to use the competition entries for marketing purposes. Photographers will be credited alongside their photographs.
20. Except for the purpose of carrying out the promotion and contacting the winner, the Promoter will not use entrants’ personal data. Visit <https://www.hants.gov.uk/aboutthecouncil/privacy> for privacy notice.

22. You agree to be bound by the decisions of the Promoter, which are final in all matters relating to the promotion. No correspondence will be entered into.

23. Participants are deemed to have accepted and agreed to be bound by these terms and conditions upon entry. The Promoter reserves the right to refuse entry or refuse to award the prize to anyone in breach of these terms and conditions.

24. These terms and conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English Law and the parties agree to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of England.

- The winner of the adult photo category will win a £50 London Camera Exchange voucher [valid for the Winchester branch].
- The winner of the under-16s photo category will win a £50 London Camera Exchange voucher [valid for the Winchester branch].
